About PSI

Park Spanish Immersion Elementary School is one of St. Louis Park Public Schools' four elementary schools and is an option you may consider for your Kindergarten student. A computerized lottery system is used to process enrollment applications for resident and non-resident students.

At PSI, students are immersed in the Spanish language while they learn reading, writing, mathematics, science, social studies, and other subject areas. The curricular content and outcomes are aligned with the District's other elementary schools, however, students at PSI are primarily instructed in Spanish rather than English.

Long-term goals for PSI students:

- Master elementary subjects (i.e. English, science, social studies, math, etc.)
- Acquire a high level of proficiency in Spanish
- Gain an understanding and appreciation of Spanish and Spanish speakers and their varied cultures
- Develop a strong foundation in English
