

**MOORESVILLE GRADED SCHOOL DISTRICT BOARD OF EDUCATION**  
**Regular Monthly Meeting, Tuesday, May 11, 2021, 6:00 p.m.**

The Board of Education of the Mooresville Graded School District met during a regular monthly session on Tuesday, May 11, 2021, in the Performing Arts Center at Mooresville High School, 659 E. Center Avenue, Mooresville, NC 28115.

Dr. Stephen Mauney, Superintendent, and Mr. Kevin Donaldson, Board Attorney, were present. Mrs. Angie Davis, Chief Finance Officer; Dr. Todd Black, Assistant Superintendent for Secondary Instruction and CTE; Dr. Scott Smith, Assistant Superintendent for Elementary Instruction and Technology; Dr. Ingrid Medlock, Assistant Superintendent for Human Resources; Dr. Michael Royal, Chief Operations Officer; Mrs. Tanae McLean, Chief Communications Officer and Title IX Coordinator; and Mrs. Sylvia Martinez, Board Clerk, were present.

Mr. Hyatt called the meeting to order, shared a quote by John Wayne, held a moment of silence and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

**Public Comment:** None

**On a motion by Mr. Whitfield, seconded by Mr. Pridgen, the board voted unanimously to approve the meeting agenda as presented.**

**On a motion by Dr. Marsh, seconded by Mrs. Pennell, the board voted unanimously to approve the minutes of the April 13, 2021, regular minutes as presented.**

**Spotlight on People:**

**a) Iredell County Health Department:** Ms. Jane Hinson and her team at the Iredell County Health Department were recognized and awarded a Certificate of Appreciation for partnering with and providing significant support and resources to MGSD throughout the past 14-months as the district navigated the Covid-19 pandemic. Mrs. McLean shared Ms. Hinson has provided guidance in understanding proper contract tracing regarding the positivity rate and Covid cases in Iredell County, and has been instrumental in helping the district make informed decisions to help keep our students and staff safe. Mrs. McLean thanked the Iredell County Health Department for the efficient drive-thru testing sites held at Mooresville High School throughout the pandemic, and for the excellent services they continue to provide to the County, MGSD, and the community.

**b) BlueSky10 - CubeSat Phase 2:** Dr. Mauney recognized and awarded certificates to the NAF Academy students on the BlueSky10 team for their participation and hard work in competing in the US Dept of Education's CTE Mission CubeSat competition, and for being one of five high school finalists chosen to participate in phase 2 of the competition. The BlueSky10 developed the CubeSat prototype which proposes to monitor and measure the effects of the town of Mooresville's growth and will address the research question: "What effect does the growth of the Town of Mooresville have on air quality, land use, and temperature?" It will be flown by drone and launched to capture weather and temperature data, air quality data, and land use images around Mooresville and the developing areas. The first test launch of the BlueSky10 prototype was held successfully at the MHS stadium on April 26, 2021. All five high school finalists will submit their flight reports on May 2021, and a judging panel will review the reports and select winners. Mrs. Parkman, CTE teacher, introduced each of the team members who provided highlights of their roles in planning, building, and launching the BlueSky10 CubeSat prototype.

**ABCD Award:** The Above and Beyond Call of Duty award was presented to Ms. Jennifer Readling, Cafeteria Manager at Mooresville Intermediate School. Ms. Readling was nominated by Ms. Kim McCall, Director of School Nutrition. In the nomination Ms. McCall wrote: "In the School Nutrition Department, Jennifer Readling is known for her creativity. In years past, she has regularly designed T-shirts for the MIS School Nutrition team as well as developed a program called MIS Cafeteria Rocks. Jennifer's positivity and creativity are a huge asset to our school nutrition program, our district, and especially to the children and families that we serve. Thank you for brightening our days during this challenging year."

**Staff Reports:**

- A. Facilities and Construction Report:** Dr. Royal provided a facilities and construction update and thanked the board members for attending the groundbreaking ceremonies held yesterday at Park View and South Elementary. He shared he recently met with staff at both schools to provide them with an update on the renovation projects that will begin soon at both schools. He will continue to update school administrators and staff as the projects progress. Dr. Royal provided an update on the athletic programs at MHS & MMS, thanked all of the coaches, athletic directors, parents, and students for a successful season, and provided final team results. The MHS softball team finished the season conference champions, and the MHS girls golf team won the conference for the 3rd- year in a row. He shared graduation preparations for the 2021 senior graduation are underway, and the Maintenance Dept. is working closely with MHS staff to prepare the campus for the ceremonies. Dr. Royal advised the annual Operations Awards Ceremony will be held at the Performing Arts Center at Mooresville High School on May 28, 2021.

- B. Instructional Report:** Dr. Smith provided an update on the K-6 grade levels and advised the 2021-2022 Kindergarten registration, Dual Immersion, and School Choice deadlines are now complete. He shared the Dual Immersion classes are at capacity with a waitlist and staff are excited to launch the program. Dr. Smith reported the second round of M-Powerment meet-ups have gone well, he shared the various PD topics covered in the sessions and advised teachers can earn CEU's by attending these voluntary self-paced PD sessions. Dr. Smith reported the State has approved the MGSD Summer Connection Plans, and he thanked K-3 Principals and MIS Principal, Dr. Pratt, for leading the planning and preparations. Dr. Smith advised the MTSS data was shared with all K-6 schools and the data is showing consistency and growth. He advised the Kindergarten Readiness Screening (KRS) will be held at Rocky River Elementary on June 1, 2021, and plans are underway for the Summer Institute which will be held at MHS in July. Dr. Black provided an update on the secondary grade levels and advised final exams at Mooresville Middle School and Mooresville High School will begin on May 18 and May 19, 2021, and the Advanced Placement (AP) exams will be completed next week. Dr. Black advised the MHS Spring Senior Capstone Projects will be held virtually on May 12, 2021, and he thanked community members, parents, and staff who volunteered to judge the projects. Dr. Black shared the dates and times for the upcoming MHS Senior Events; Senior Scholarship Night, Senior E3, and Baccalaureate Service. He indicated due to Covid-19, the Class of 2021 will have two commencement ceremonies at the Joe Popp Stadium on May 28, 2021, and May 29, 2021. Lastly, Dr. Black advised an overview of the MGSD Summer Connection Plans and the CTE Local Plan would be presented to the board later in the evening.
- C. Business Services Report:** Mrs. Davis advised the virtual district staff meetings she was recently attending to present staff the updated 2021-2022 Play Plan information have concluded. She shared DPI has retired the State Installment System which affects all of our 10 and 11-month employees and thanked Dr. Mauney, Dr. Medlock, and Mrs. McLean for assisting in these virtual staff meetings. Mrs. Davis reported the MGSD Finance Department has implemented holding monthly virtual meetings with all school and district financial data managers to provide them support, professional development, and to share best practices and upcoming financial deadlines. Mrs. Davis advised the MGSD staff reimbursement procedure has been streamlined and MGSD staff will now receive their reimbursement payments via direct deposit in lieu of paper checks.
- D. Human Resources Report:** Dr. Medlock reported the 2021 Teacher of the Year and Beginning Teacher of the Year selection process is now complete and thanked the committee members for their participation. The TOY & BTOY district winners will be announced at the MGSD Convocation on July 26, 2021. She advised the (BTSP) Beginning Teacher Support Program held their end of year celebration and the district's current BTOY, Felicia Tapper and TOY, Yevette Peveler, were guest speakers at the event. Dr. Medlock thanked the Beginning Teachers and their Mentors for their hard work and accomplishments and congratulated the 3rd year

teachers for graduating from the program. Dr. Medlock shared that the 2021 NC Educator's License Renewal applications are now open, and educators may renew their licenses through the NCDPI online Licensure System this year through the end of July. Dr. Medlock shared that she would present and request board approval for the 2021-2022 contract recommendations during the closed session. Lastly, Dr. Medlock provided an update of the MGSD Staff COVID-19 Reports since our last board meeting on April 13, 2021; a total of **17** COVID-19 Staff Reports have been made bringing the total to **561** staff reports; out of the **17** new COVID-19 reports, **11** of those reports are staff members exposed to someone who was either symptomatic or tested positive bringing the total exposure cases to **361** out of **561** staff reports; out of the **17** new COVID-19 reports, **3** staff members tested positive, bringing the total of positive cases to **121** out of **561** reports; and a total of **16** staff members have quarantined since our last board meeting bringing the total to **544** staff members have needed to quarantine (approx. 77% of total staff).

- E. Public Communications Report:** Mrs. McLean shared that she recently completed the Intercultural Development Inventory (IDI) Qualifying Training and advised IDI is used by major corporations, schools, and organizations to help build intercultural competence and to achieve diversity and inclusion goals and outcomes. She advised the IDI will first be administered to the executive leadership team to determine their strengths and needs, and to develop a plan to address growth needs. Mrs. McLean shared the Pfizer vaccination was recently approved for children ages 12 and up and MGSD will be working with the Iredell County Health Department this summer to offer vaccination clinics to our students. She gave a special shout out to the district school nurses in honor of School Nurse Appreciation Day and thanked them all for their phenomenal work during this difficult time. Mrs. McLean shared the current Iredell County COVID-19 data for MGSD employees and students as of today, May 8, 2021; Total Quarantines: 195 (10 staff members and 185 students); Close Contacts: 173 (7 staff members and 166 students); Symptomatic: 12 (2 staff members and 10 students); Positive Individuals: 11 (2 staff members and 9 students).
- F. Superintendent's Report:** Dr. Mauney reported in honor of Teacher Appreciation Week last week, MGSD teachers were celebrated and recognized for their outstanding with good treats, food, and many great activities. He shared MGSD is fortunate to have such a dedicated group of caring, qualified educators, and thanked them for their selfless work and their continued focus to engage and form positive relationships with our students. Dr. Mauney congratulated all of MGSD's third year beginning teachers for graduating from the Beginning Teachers Support Program and gave a special thank you to Dr. Medlock for leading the BTSP and supporting our beginning teachers during the crucial early years of their career. He gave a shout-out to the Curriculum & Instruction team and thanked them for their work in preparing and planning the district's summer program with the new state requirements, and for their time and effort in building a summer program that will address the needs of our students on a larger scale than ever before.

**G. Board Events and Announcements:** The board reviewed the upcoming events as listed on the calendars included in their May board packet. Mr. Hyatt shared the 2020-2021 end of year school board meeting will be held on June 30, 2021, and board members will be attending the 2021 NCSBA Summer Leadership and Policy Conference in Carolina Beach, NC from June 14 - June 18, 2021.

**Approval of Appointment to the Mitchell Community College Board of Trustees:** Dr. Mauney presented his recommendation for the reappointment of Mr. George W. Brawley, Jr. to serve another four-year term on the Mitchell Community College Board of Trustees, which will begin July 1, 2021. **On a motion by Mr. Pridgen, seconded by Dr. Marsh, the board voted unanimously to approve the reappointment of George W. Brawley, Jr. to a four-year term on the Mitchell Community College Board of Trustees that will begin on July 1, 2021.**

**Overview of 2020-2021 MGSD Summer Programs:** Dr. Black and Dr. Smith presented an overview of the 2021 MGSD Summer Connection Program that was recently submitted and approved by the state. They provided the new NC state summer school program requirements for K-8 and 9-12 grade levels and advised the program would be open to all students but prioritizing at-risk students. Dr. Smith provided an overview of the summer program plans for the K-6 grade levels, shared the social and emotional lessons, team building, and resources that will be utilized in the summer program, and advised the program will focus on connecting with learners academically and socially. Dr. Black provided the total amount of students expected to attend the summer program, shared the at-risk identification process used for students in the secondary grade levels, provided a daily schedule sample for students at MMS & MHS, and shared the social-emotional support and curricular resources that will be used for students in the 7-12 grade levels.

**Approval of CTE Local Plan:** Mrs. Julie Blocker, Coordinator for the MGSD Career and Technical Education (CTE) Program, presented the 2021-2022 CTE Local Plan and projected budget, and gave an overview of the plan and some of the changes. She also provided highlights of the current 2020-2021 CTE program. **On a motion by Dr. Marsh, seconded by Mr. Whitfield, the board voted unanimously to approve the 2021-2022 CTE Local Plan as presented.**

**Approval of Supplemental Tax Rate:** Mrs. Davis presented the 2021-2022 supplemental tax rate at the same rate as the previous year. The Supplemental tax rate for the Mooresville Graded School District will remain at 18.5 cents per \$100.00 assessment. **On a motion by Dr. Marsh, seconded by Mr. Pridgen, the board voted unanimously to approve the Supplemental Tax Rate as presented.**

**Updated Board Policy - For Approval:** Mrs. Davis asked the board to approve the updated Board policy that was presented in April for first read. **On a motion by Mrs. Pennell, seconded by Mr. Whitfield, the board voted unanimously to approve the updated board policy as presented.**
