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# **Enrolling at South Washington County Schools**

South Washington County Schools provides a great elementary school in every neighborhood. Students will meet new friends, gain problem-solving skills and will develop socially and emotionally in a caring and supportive school. Students will learn through language arts, math, science, social studies, health and physical education, music, art and media literacy.



# **How to Apply**

## 1. Review

Visit sowashco.org/apply and use our boundary map to determine your boundary school.

Determine if a choice program is right for your child. See more about the programs available on pages 6-8.

## 2. Gather

Gather your child's:

- Birth Certificate
- Immunization records
- Address verifications
- Proof of completion of state required health and developmental screening. More information can be found on page 12.

# 3. Apply

Applications for your boundary school and choice programs can be filled out online at sowashco.org/apply.

Please complete the priority application by Friday, Feb. 26.

# 4. Notification

Students accepted to a choice program will be notified in March.

Families will be notified of their child's boundary school placement in April.

Your school will provide open house information once enrolled.

## 5. Learn More

Pending the latest COVID-19 restrictions, your school will provide opportunities to meet staff, tour classrooms and discover the different programs available to your child.

Schools will send more information in April and August.

# Who Should Apply?

## An application is required if:

Your child will be entering kindergarten or will be new to the school district for the 2021-22 school year.

## Applications are not required for students who are:

Continuing at their current school to the next grade level

## **Admission Priorities**

## Priority is given to those who:


- Live within the area of their boundary school
- Residents living within South Washington County Schools boundaries
- Children of South Washington County Schools employees
- Siblings of current open enrolled students attending South Washington County Schools
  - Sibling priority does not guarantee acceptance into the district

## Other Considerations:


- Students living outside of South Washington County Schools boundaries are admitted to district schools if space allows.
  - Families must complete an open enrollment form which can be found at sowashco.org/apply.

# **Waiting Lists**

Waiting lists are created for schools and programs that receive more applications than they have space available. Families that apply to a choice program will remain on the waiting list for one school year. If their child is not selected within the year, families will need to reapply. Families applying for a choice program must also first apply for the boundary school that serves the area in which they live.




- During the enrollment application process, South Washington County Schools will gather information about a student and family's language background.
- Families that identify a home language other than English will have their child screened to determine if they qualify for English Language services.
- English language coordinators will reach out to families to schedule screenings for students before the upcoming school year.

# **Choice Programs**

South Washington County Schools offers two choice programs, the Multiage Choice Program at Valley Crossing and Nuevas Fronteras Spanish Immersion.

#### Good to Know

- Families applying for a choice program must follow the same process for enrollment at sowashco.org/apply by first selecting their boundary school before filling out a choice program application.
  - There is a separate application for applying to a choice program. A link to this is included in the boundary school application.

## **Eligibility and Lottery Information**

- Students within South Washington County Schools boundaries are given first preference for enrollment in choice programs.
- Students with siblings already enrolled in choice programs will be given priority.
- Enrollment for Nuevas Fronteras Spanish Immersion and Valley Crossing Multiage Program is determined by a lottery process.
- Families will be notified with the results of the lottery process in March.
- Families not selected by the lottery process will be placed on a waiting list and are encouraged to attend their boundary school.

# **Nuevas Fronteras Spanish Immersion K-5**

**Districtwide transportation** provided to students who live within the district, and who live more than one mile from school.

At **Nuevas Fronteras Spanish Immersion**, students will gain skills and knowledge in the core content areas of reading, writing, math and science through instruction in Spanish. Students will develop positive attitudes about people who speak another language and for those who come from other cultures. By fifth grade, students will understand, speak, read and write in Spanish.

## **Additional Information**

- Students in kindergarten and first grade engage in activities that focus on their social-emotional learning and academics while being immersed in Spanish.
- Students in second grade continue to use Spanish for the majority of the day while also receiving English instruction for about 30-50 minutes every day.
- Students in third through fifth grade receive more English instruction to prepare them for their time at the middle and high school levels, while maintaining a large portion of their day in Spanish.
- In addition to core subjects, we offer art, music, science and physical education.
- This program is great for families that want their child to learn spanish or for families of native Spanish speakers.



Valley Crossing Multiage Program K-5

**Districtwide transportation** provided to students who live within the district, and live more than one mile from the school.

The Multiage Choice Program allows students to develop relationships with the same team of teachers and classmates over a two-year period. Classrooms are grouped together as kindergarten and first grade, second and third grade and fourth and fifth grade. Instruction focuses on individual progress in both academic and social-emotional areas.

## **Additional Information**

- The mix of grade levels allows students of different abilities and ages to work together.
- Relationships are strengthened between child, teacher and family to directly contribute to personalized learning.
- Each classroom is comprised of students with a wide range of skills and abilities where their differences are expected and honored.
- Students are able to be matched with the skill level they are ready for academically.
- Multiage classrooms offer opportunities for students to be mentored and/or to be a mentor.
- Teachers work together on teams and students may work with another teacher on the team for part of the day (reading and/or math).
- Science and social studies topics are covered over a two-year period.
- Multiage students have the same specialist classes found in other SoWashCo elementary schools (art, media, music, and physical education).

# **Transportation Guidelines**

## **Transportation Guidelines**

Transportation may be available for students who live within South Washington County Schools boundaries. Eligible students are assigned to a bus stop based on their home address, or in some situations, a daycare address. Traffic hazard factors and distance are the two primary criteria used to establish transported areas. For more information visit sowashco.org/transportation or call 651-425-5303.

Grades	Guidelines
K-5	School bus transportation will generally be provided for elementary students who live <b>more than one mile</b> from their boundary school.
6-8	School bus transportation will generally be provided for middle school students who live <b>more than one-and-a-half miles</b> from their boundary school.
9-12	School bus transportation will generally be provided for high school students who live <b>more than two miles</b> from their boundary school.
Choice Programs	School bus transportation will generally be provided for students attending Nuevas Fronteras Spanish Immersion Elementary School and live more than one mile from the school.  School bus transportation will generally be provided for students attending the multiage program at Valley Crossing Elementary School and live more than one mile from the school.

**Please note:** Transportation boundaries are subject to change. Open enrolled and intra-district transfer students (students attending a school other than their boundary school) whose parent/guardian has signed a waiver of transportation are not eligible for transportation services regardless of the distance.

## **Kids Club**

Kids Club is a fee-based child care program that supports learning and development before and/or after school, on non-school days and during summer. The program is open to elementary students in grades K-5 at their school.

#### **School Year**

#### 6:30 a.m. - 6 p.m.

- Before and/or after school scheduling.
- All SoWashCo elementary schools.
- Full-time (5 days a week) or part-time (1-4 days a week) scheduling before and/or after school.
- Drop-in attendance option available.
- Care on non-school days is available to current Kids Club participants at limited locations. Registration is required for non-school days.

#### Summer

#### 6:30 a.m. – 6 p.m.

- Full-day and half-day scheduling.
- Programming available for students who have completed their kindergarten year.

#### **Athletics and Activities**

#### Early Childhood Screening

Early Childhood Screening is a simple check of how a child is growing and developing. It is required for any child entering kindergarten and is free of charge. Call 651-425-6175 or visit ce.sowashco.org/earlychildhood.



#### **Immunizations**

State law requires that all students are current with certain immunizations before starting school unless there is an exemption on file. Students will not be able to attend school until immunization dates or exemption information is turned into the school. More information is available at sowashco.org/immunizations.



#### Medications

Health services personnel dispense medication to students in need of medication during school hours. Requirements and forms are available at sowashco.org/medications.



#### **Parent Portal**

#### Pay Fees

This system will be used for processing payments for school fees (parking, transcripts, clubs, etc.) and competitive activities (soccer, hockey, speech team, etc.). You can set up an account at sowashco.org/fees.

You can register and manage your student's account at sowashco.org/mealaccounts. Follow the instructions to setup an account and manage funds with a credit card. Applications for Free and Reduced-Priced Meals are available online, at your child's school and the District Service Center.



#### **School Supply Lists**

#### **Transportation**

Transportation will be provided to and from school for eligible students to their boundary school. Families will receive bus stop information in August. More information is available at sowashco.org/transportation.
