



Grading guidelines for reading standards:
“Knows and applies grade level phonics and decoding skills”
“Reads grade level text accurately”
Reads grade level text fluently”

- IF a student is being progress monitored regularly, no additional end of trimester assessment should be needed
- For students who might earn a ‘3’ or ‘4’ the following is a list of resources you can use to assess their reading level:
 - **ONE** progress monitor passage*
 - End of year story from Journeys
 - End of grade level Read Naturally passage (ie. 2nd grade = 2.9)
 - End of year On Level leveled reader
 - End of year AR book or portion of (ie. 3rd grade = 3.9)
 - End of year Fresh Read
 - Select passage @ ReadWorks.org, you can select by grade or lexile level as well as fiction or non-fiction
 - If timed, meet the end of year benchmark wcpm # and % accuracy with appropriate expression and pacing
 - 1st grade = 47wcpm
 - 2nd grade = 87wcpm
 - 3rd grade = 100wcpm
 - 4th grade = 115wcpm
 - 5th grade = 130wcpm
- *grade levels may identify ONE Progress Monitor passage per trimester if desired for an additional common reading assessment, they can choose as a school or entire grade level
- **Please note that no SINGLE assessment should be used for any grade on the Progress Report**
