***<u>DIRECTIONS</u>: The first 2 assignments below should be hand-written on notebook paper, not typed. (Either cursive or print is acceptable.)

SUMMARIES:

- 1) Write a chapter summary for each chapter.
- 2) Summaries should be 3-5 sentences long and should include important characters, plot details, and setting.

VOCABULARY:

Make a list of 10 vocabulary words you learned while reading the novel.
 Write the dictionary definition next to each word.

TABLEAU:

- 1) Use a ½ size poster board (white) and neatly divide it into 8 equal square sections.
- 2) In each section, illustrate a scene from *The Westing Game* using the entire section. Scenes should be drawn in sequential (chronological) order and should be detailed and colorful. You may use markers, colored pencils, paint, etc. You may add texture or a 3-D effect (optional).
- 3) On the back, number each square, and write 1-2 sentences explaining what is happening in each section of the tableau.

4) Please put your first and last name on the back in the bottom left corner.
