The Tangipahoa Parish School System is pleased to announce the continuation of the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) Program for the 2020-2021 school year. This program will allow all students to receive a healthy breakfast and lunch every school day free of charge. During this unprecedented school year, TPSS has made a few changes regarding meal service operations. In addition to providing meals to students attending school on campus, we are offering curbside meal pick-up at the following locations (Tuesdays and Thursdays-10:00 a.m.-12:00 noon) for those students who are participating in virtual learning from home:

Phase I: Amite High Magnet, Hammond Westside Montessori, Hammond High Magnet, Independence High Magnet, Sumner High, O.W. Dillon Leadership Academy, and Ponchatoula High

Phase II: Hammond High Magnet, Independence High Magnet, and Sumner High

In hopes of resuming to normal meal service operations, students will still be required to pay for second meals and/or extra sales items, as they are not included in the program. No fees are required to participate in this program. Parents/guardians will no longer be required to complete an application for meal benefits for their child or children. The only requirement to participate in this program is for the child or children to be enrolled in one of the Tangipahoa Parish Schools listed below:
