## THE JOHN HOMANS MASON MEMORIAL PRIZE

John Homans Mason was a graduate of Dexter, Class of 1957. He was a Justice of the Massachusetts Appeals Court, where he was known for his thorough preparation and persuasive argument which was always tempered with gentleness, civility, and a generosity of spirit. Wise, too, was his counsel as Clerk of the Dexter and Southfield Boards of Trustees, where he was unwavering in his dedication to the traditions and missions of the Schools.

This memorial prize is awarded to a boy in Class 12 who shares the traits that John Mason had of civility, generosity of spirit, and dedication to his community and to his friends.
