School Device & Internet Use for Primary Students

There are measures in place to support the use of devices and internet use for learning.

- Students are supervised when using devices and use them in limited time quantities.
- Students will not be taking school owned devices home.
- Students' internet access is filtered.
- Device and internet rules are taught and regularly communicated to students. These rules are a part of our curricular lessons about digital citizenship, including how to be safe on the internet. These rules are included in this packet.
- We use [Common Sense Media](#) for much of our curricular content and recommend this resource for families as they consider technology use for their children at home.

Inappropriate Use/Internet Violation Examples

- Your child does not have a right to privacy; teachers and administrators have access to everything students are doing.
- Students are not allowed to download or install software on school devices.
- Students are not to delete their internet browsing history.
- Inappropriate use or neglectful care of devices or purposefully not following internet rules will result in disciplinary action. This may include loss of privilege to use the device for a period of time.
