SSHAC Establishment

The Eanes ISD School Safety and Health Advisory Council (SSHAC) was established by the Eanes Independent School District in accordance with:

- Chapter 28, Sections 28.002 and 28.004; and Chapter 38, Section 38.014 of the Texas Education Code**
- Enacted by Senate Bill 19 during the 77th session of the Legislature of the State of Texas in 2001.**



SSHAC Purpose

The SSHAC serves as an advisory committee to the Board with consultation to the district administration:

- Assists the district in ensuring local community values are reflected in the district's health education instruction. District must consider the recommendations of the SSHAC before making changes to the district's health education curriculum or instruction.**
- Assists the district in working toward the implementation of coordinated health programs for elementary and middle school students.**

The Eanes ISD Board of Trustees may expand the scope of SSHAC activity to advise on health and safety issues as they arise.

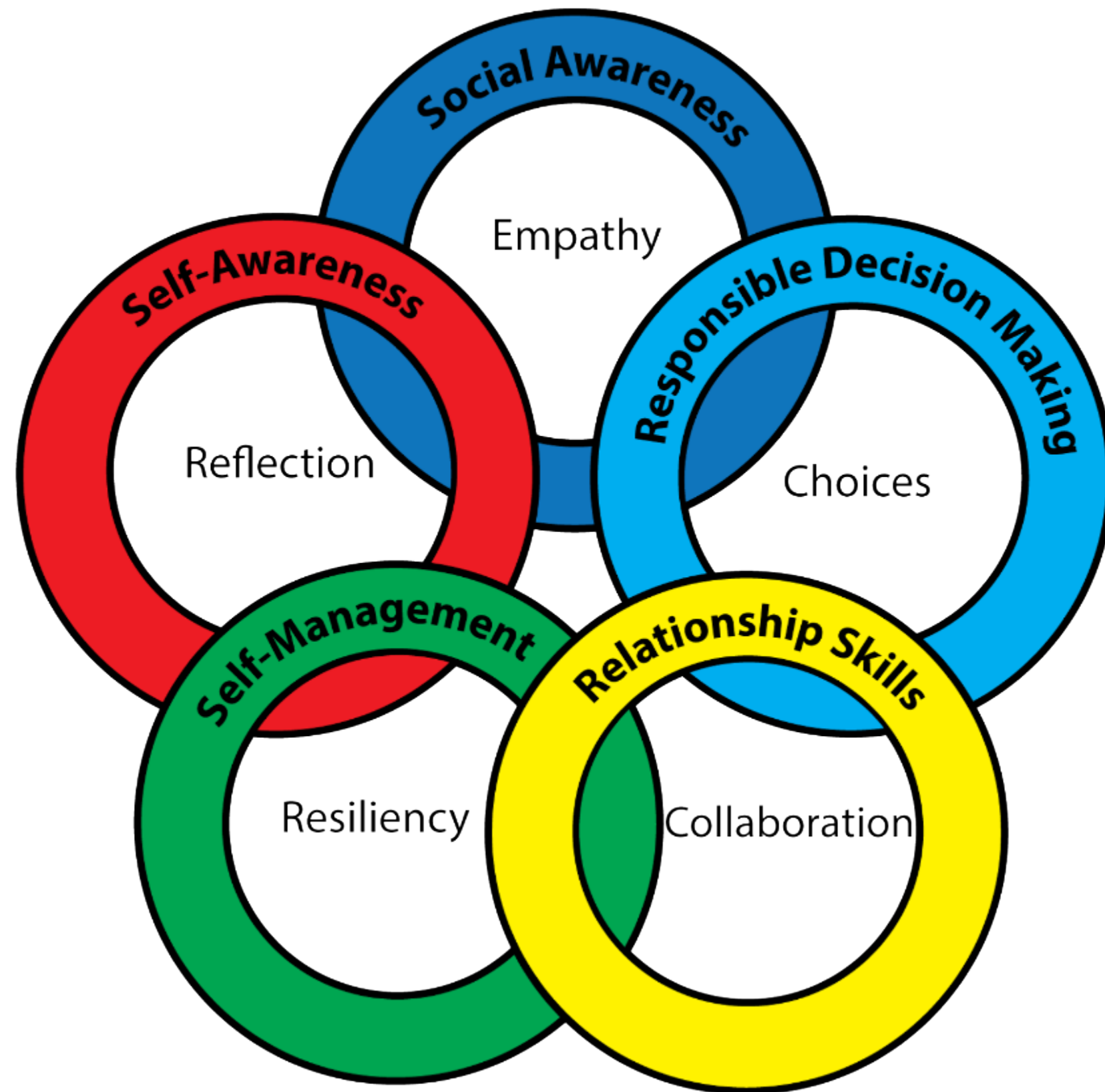

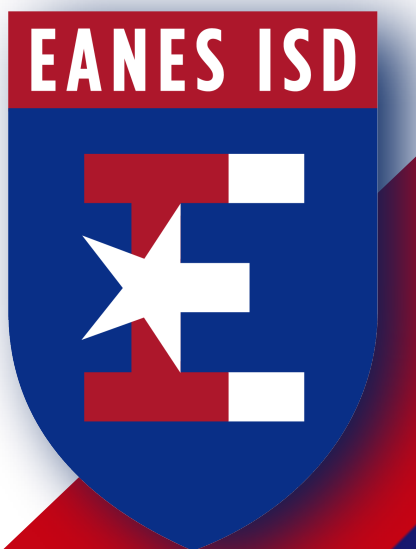
