## **Summer School 2021**

Monday 23rd August to Friday 27th August 2021, 9am – 3pm (students to arrive at 8:45am)

Eggtooth, along with The Hastings Academy staff will be delivering The Hastings Academy Transition Summer School.

The Summer School is a very popular week, and we are limited to the number of students we can accommodate. Places at the Summer School as well as the allocation to teams will be on a **first come first served basis.** 

Some teams are also limited due to a maximum number. In the event that the team you wish your child to be a part of reaches its maximum number, we will offer you your 2nd choice team, so please ensure you select a different team as your 2nd choice.

All students will experience a taster session of all the other Teams activities.

The Summer School is a varied, fun and exciting week that is based on site at The Hastings Academy.

We will be providing a free healthy breakfast for all students every morning, however, a packed lunch is needed for lunchtime. If your child is eligible for free school meals, we will provide lunch for them.

There are 5 teams to choose from:

- 1. **Team Sport:** You will focus on the following sports: football, cricket, boxing, golf, personal fitness, nutrition, table tennis and basketball.
- 2. **Team Cook:** You will work with a professional chef. You will create dishes that are local, national and international and you will cook with ingredients you may or may not recognise!
- 3. **Team Perform:** Under the guidance of professional musicians and performers you will experiment with musical instruments and sounds. You will play games and learn a lot about yourself. If you sing this will be a brilliant opportunity to develop your voice and your performing skills.
- 4. **Team Forest:** You will spend the whole of your sessions in The Hastings Academy woodland area. You will learn woodcraft skills, fire lighting, shelter building, survival techniques and understand the local wildlife and environment.
- 5. **Team Create:** You will be based in the Art Room with professional artists. You will paint, draw, learn about colour, illustrate and make some fantastic pieces of art.

The Summer School week will be professionally filmed, edited and produced by REDKITE FILMS and available for all students and parents to download to remind them of their special time at The Hastings Academy Summer School 2021.
