English

This week we will be reading more of the book 'The Magic Finger' and will be focusing on using plurals and suffixes in our writing. We will be using our imagination and artistic skills to draw a scene from the book and describe what we have drawn. We will be writing a poem and completing a diary entry as though we are one of the Gregg children.

Wider curriculum

In History this week we will be continuing to explore the Great Fire of London. We will be thinking about how we know about the fire, in particular, the diaries of Samuel Pepys.

In science we will be exploring the woods and looking for things that are living, have never lived or are no longer alive and observing how plants can offer shelter for animals.

Maths

This week we will be recapping on repeated addition and how it links to multiplication. We will be learning that statements such as 5+5+5 is equivalent to 3 x 5. We will then be using our knowledge to solve word problems including in the context of money.

Sounds Write

This week we will continue to learn to spell and build words containing the sound /j/. There are four different spellings for /j, /j/ as in jump, /g/ as in gigantic and /ge/ as in huge and /dge/ as in fridge.
