PLEASE NOTE: Students may miss ONLY ONE school lesson a week.

Rotational lessons – students will miss a different subject lesson (including core subjects) each week. This usually means one subject lesson is missed per half term to ensure minimum disruption to the curriculum. In *some exceptional cases* and where it is *unavoidable* students may miss a subject twice per half term.

All Speech and Drama lessons for students in Year 7-9 are on a rotational basis.

Fixed lessons – these lessons are held before or after School or at lunchtimes. Spaces are limited so are only available to senior students (Years 10 and above) or students learning more than one instrument (i.e the 2nd priority choice instrument).

The number of places for tuition is limited and cannot be guaranteed immediately but we do operate a waiting list system where necessary.

Students are expected to attend on the dates and times set out in the weekly timetable and it is the student's responsibility to ensure they get to/from their lessons on time.

Starting/terminating Lessons: Lessons usually start at the beginning of any term. One full term's notice is required to terminate lessons. Notice should be in writing to the Peripatetic teacher and in the first week of the beginning of term.

Fees: Lessons are 35 minutes (30 lessons p.a). Fees are payable termly in advance.

Missed Lessons: Lessons missed due to the peripatetic teacher's absence will either be made up or refunded. Lessons missed through a student's non-attendance will be charged for as the peripatetic teacher has to attend School for that lesson whether or not the student attends. Only lessons missed due to a scheduled school calendar event will be rescheduled or made up providing reasonable advance notice is given by the student or parent/carer. As peripatetic staff only teach on designated days, there may be a rare occasion when an event (e.g. sports fixture) clashes with an instrumental lesson which is beyond the control of the Speech and Drama and Music Departments. Whilst every endeavour will be made to avoid clashes and to rearrange the lesson, this may not always be possible. Since we are unable to refund the cost of the instrumental lesson, it will be parental choice as to which activity the student attends.

Insurance: The School's insurance does not cover personal instruments and these should be insured through your own insurance company.

The School makes every effort to safeguard instruments and to provide safe storage but cannot accept responsibility for any damage to instruments belonging to students. Instruments must be taken home at the end of the week and during holidays.

Commitment: It is expected that those having performing arts lessons will be invited to join orchestras, choirs and/or ensembles or take part in assemblies, concerts etc.
