Instructional Delivery Plan for Quarantined Students, 2021-22

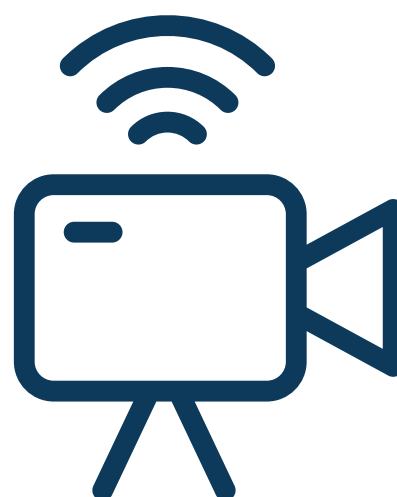
Grades K-2

Any materials students should complete will be provided online through Canvas and/or for pickup in the school office.



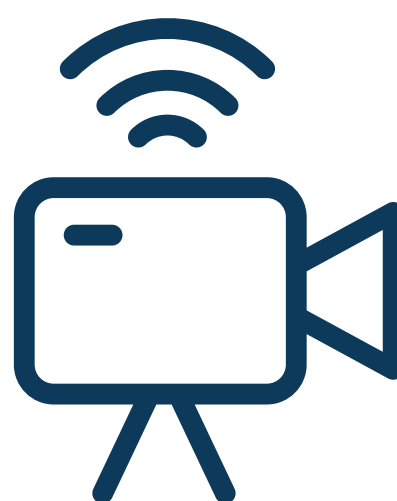
Grades 3-5

Students will participate via livestreaming (not synchronous instruction*) for whole-class reading, writing, and math lessons. Additional learning experiences (science, social studies, workshops, etc.) will be determined by the teacher based on overall feasibility of the activities. Any materials students should complete will be provided online through Canvas and/or for pickup in the school office.



Grades 6-8

Student participation via livestreaming (not synchronous instruction*) will be determined by the teacher each class period based on feasibility of the activities. Any materials students should complete will be provided online through Canvas and/or for pickup in the school office.



*Livestreaming

Livestreaming will be different from the synchronous instruction provided during the 2020-2021 school year. Livestreaming is defined as transmitting feasible classroom instruction via Zoom for students to be able to view only. Therefore, students will be able to do this only for lessons where material is projected to the class on a screen or flat panel. We recognize not every lesson can be livestreamed as our teachers move back to more hands-on and optimal instruction this school year.

Livestreaming will only be used for students who are quarantined due to diagnosis of COVID-19 or close contact. This opportunity is not available to students who are home due to illness (other than COVID-19) or traveling. Students who are home due to extenuating circumstances (ex. recovering from surgery) will be considered on a case-by-case basis.
