109. SCHOOL LIBRARIES	
1. Purpose	The Board believes that school libraries are an essential component of a sound educational program. School libraries provide information and services to all students and faculty that ensure intellectual freedom and growth in a pluralistic society.
2. Delegation of Responsibility	The Board delegates selection of school library materials/resources to the School Library Media Specialist, in consultation with faculty and administration and, when appropriate, students and parents/guardians. Selection objectives, criteria and procedures shall be in accordance with established administrative regulations or district procedures.
3. Guidelines	<p>A list of school library materials/resources provided by the district shall be maintained by the administration and shall be available to Board members, district staff, students, parents/guardians and community members.</p> <p>Requests for reconsideration of school library materials/resources shall be Chapter 14 compliant and in accordance with established administrative regulations or district procedures.</p> <p>References:</p> <p>School Code – 24 P.S.
