CLASS RANK</p> <p>The Board acknowledges the necessity for a system of computing grade point averages and class rank for secondary school students to inform students, parents/guardians and others of their relative academic placement among their peers.</p> <p>The Board authorizes a system of class rank, by grade point average, for students in grades 9-12. All students shall be ranked together.</p> <p>Class rank shall be computed by the final grade in all subjects for which credit is awarded.</p> <p>Any two (2) or more students whose computed grade point averages are identical shall be given the same rank. The rank of the student who immediately follows a tied position will be determined by the number of students preceding and not by the rank of the proceeding person.</p> <p>A student's grade point average and rank in class shall be entered on the student's record and transcripts and shall be subject to Board policy on release of student records.</p> <p><u>Weighted Grades</u></p> <p>Courses designated as advanced shall be weighted for the purpose of ascertaining class rank, as determined by the Board.</p> <p>The Superintendent or designee shall develop administrative regulations for computing grade point averages and assigning class rank to implement this policy.</p> <p>References:</p> <p>School Code – 24 P.S.
