Services Provided

The RHS School Counseling Team is here to support with Academic Development throughout the students time in high school. Our goal is for students to have academic achievement by implementing strategies for success in the classroom.

College and Career Development is a concentration of the state, the school district and RHS. Students will receive support in the application process to any post-secondary institution, testing information and financial aid support. An emphasis on career exploration and planning will be implemented.

Personal and Social Development is an integral part of the high school experience and aids in positive outcomes. A connection to the school through extra curricular activities, club involvement and leadership programs will increase student performance.

As part of the students collaborative team, RHS School Counselors, will provide services upon request and through assigned grade level curriculum.

Become University Bound by Completing the A-G Requirements

In order to be eligible to apply to a University of California (UC) or California State University (CSU), students need to complete their A-G course requirements. Students need to complete all of these courses with a letter grade of "C" or better to be eligible. A	Social Science	2 Years
B	English	4 Years
C	Mathematics	3 Years or 4 recommended
D	Science	2 years or 3 recommended
E	Language Other Than English (LOTE)	2 Years of the Same Language
F	Visual and Performing Arts (VAPA)	1 Year
G	College Prep Elective	1 Year
