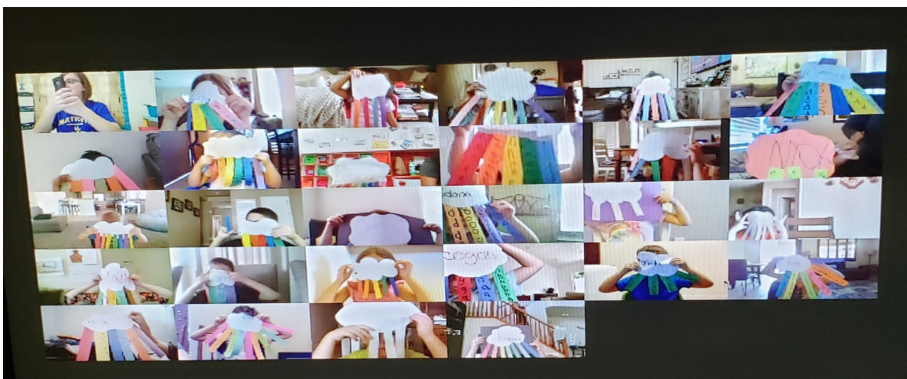


## STEAM LEARNING AT HOME WITH MR. REYNOLDS' CLASS
