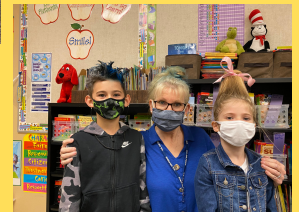


Before-and-After-School Care Services
