

COMMUNITY SERVICE REQUIREMENTS

Since Metrolina Christian Academy seeks to instill a sense of commitment to serving others, students in grades 9 through 12 are required to complete community service hours each year. These community service hours will be tracked and reported through their Bible classes by the third quarter using the [Community Service Documentation Form](#). This form can also be found on the MCA website under Academics/Upper School/Warrior Service Program. The following are the number of hours required for each grade level:

2021-22 Academic Year (Half the normal amount)	2022-23 Academic Year
Freshman: 8 hours	Freshman: 16 hours
Sophomores: 10 hours	Sophomores: 20 hours
Juniors: 12 hours	Juniors: 24 hours
Seniors: 14 hours	Seniors: 28 hours

The required hours have been reduced for the 2021-22 Academic Year to compensate for limitations caused by the pandemic.

Other information regarding earning community service hours:

- All mission trip participants receive half ($\frac{1}{2}$) credit toward the hourly service (ex: Freshman can receive 8 hours for a mission trip, Sophomores can receive 10, etc.).
- School clubs and organizations may conduct service projects in which students may receive credit for that club and for the service program.
- Students may participate in service projects for their church or for any nonprofit organization.
- Supervisors' names and phone numbers are required on the documentation
