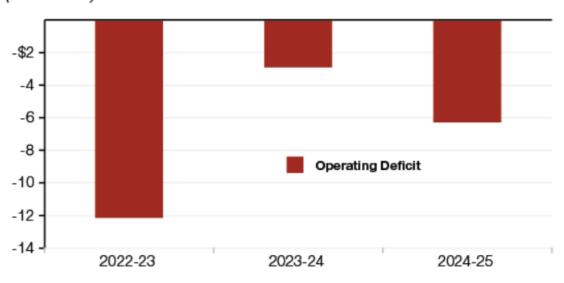






Tustin Unified School District State and Education Budget Updates Cont.

(In Billions)

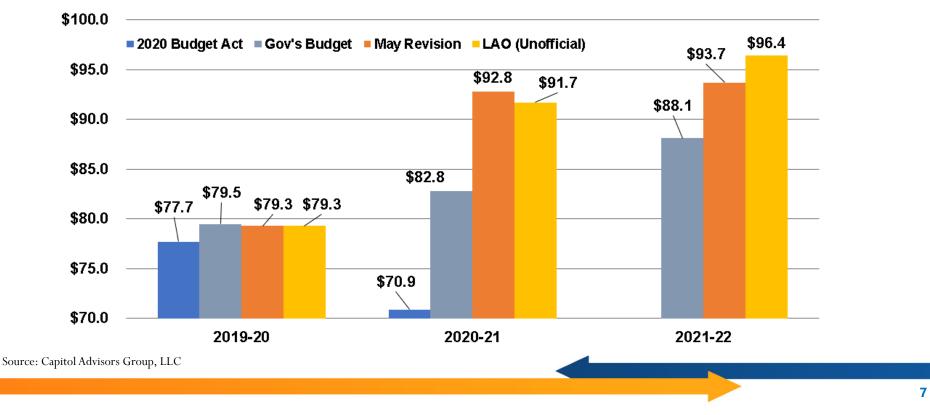

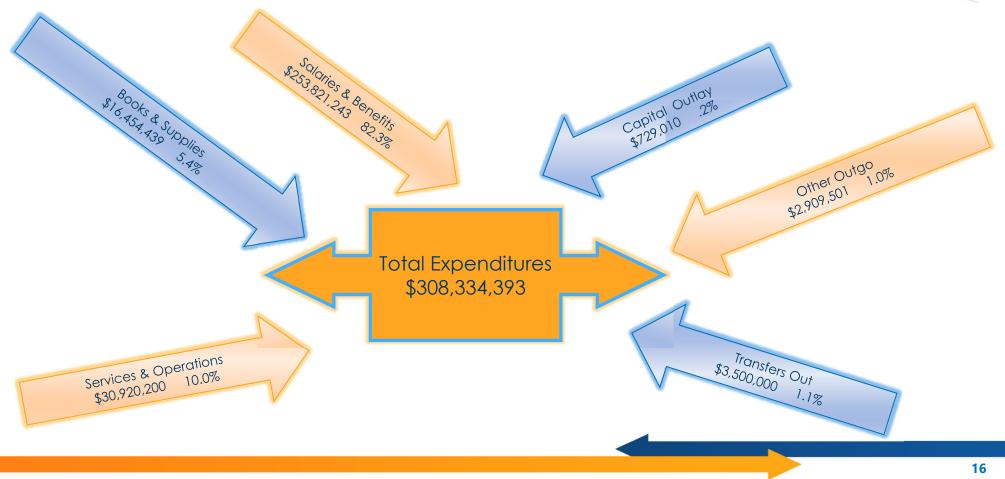


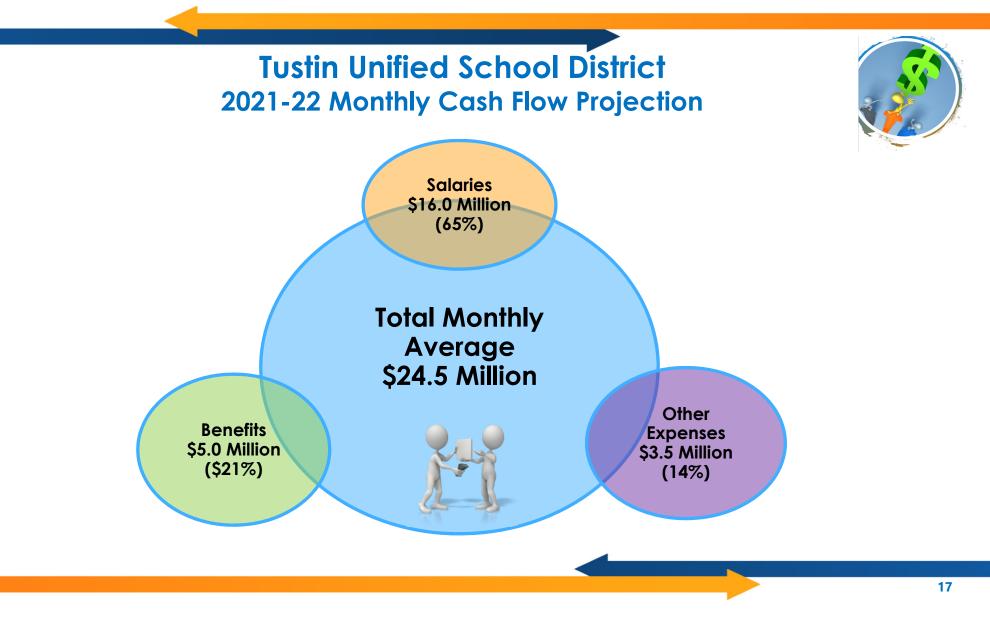


Tustin Unified School District 2021-22 Revenue Projection









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Tustin Unified School District Multi-Year Projections



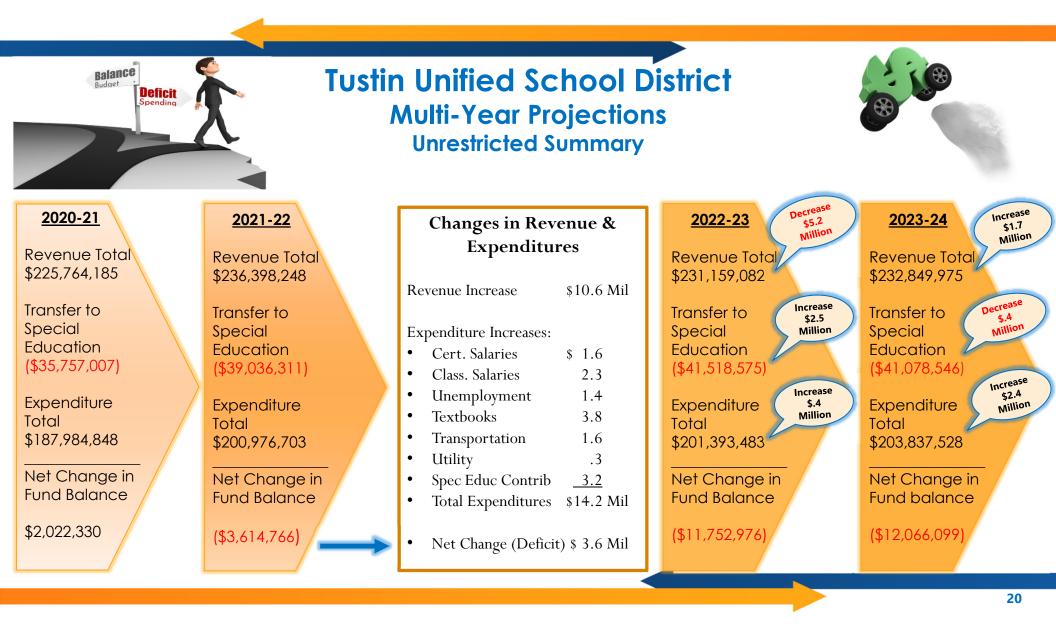

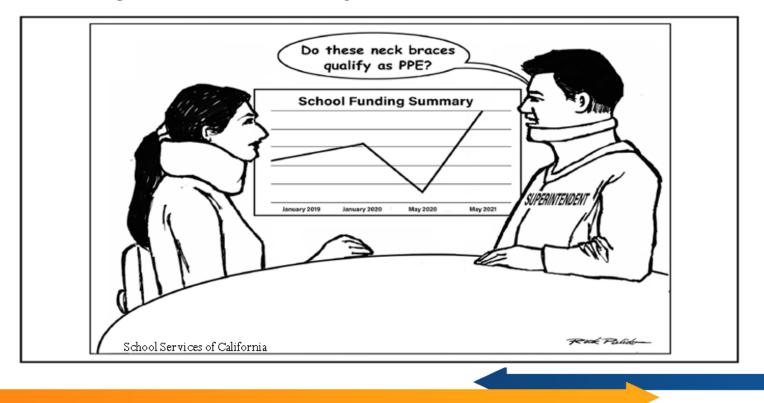
