

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

UC Admission

Many of our students apply to the University of California (UC) system, and all of the LyceeLA's graduation requirements meet or exceed the UC admission standards.

Course Load

All students in 9th -12th grade must take a minimum of 5 academic courses per year.

Outside Courses

Courses taken at other high schools, colleges, or online must be pre-approved by the Head of High School and College Counselor. Please note that the LyceeLA transcript only lists courses taken at LyceeLA and therefore, the coursework taken at other institutions will not be factored into the LyceeLA grade point average. The original transcript received from the issuing institution is provided to the colleges who are able to re-calculate the student's GPA, if needed.



In order to graduate from Le Lycée Français de Los Angeles, a student must complete, with a passing grade, a minimum of 20 courses in 9th-12th grades, including the following high school year-long courses:

English: 4 courses (includes Composition/Literature)

Mathematics: 4 courses (includes at least Algebra 1 and Geometry)

Science: 2 courses (includes Biology, Chemistry and/or Physics)

Social Science: 3 courses (must include US and World History)

Languages other than English: 2 courses (4 recommended) - French is required for all students*

Visual or Performing Arts: 2 courses - Integrated Arts (Music & Literature is required for all 9th graders)

Philosophy: Required course taken during 11th or 12th grade

Physical Education: 4 courses* (French School Program requires 4 years - no exceptions)

Electives: 3 UC approved courses

Community Service: strongly encouraged

*exemption for International School Program (ISP) students possible based on pre-approval from Head of High School
