

# CHCA Intercession 2022

**Overview:** Students will travel to Disney World where they will perform dance pieces (prepared in advance) for guests at the park. The second piece of the outreach will include blessing the staff at the resort with small gifts and tokens of encouragement.

- Course Goals:**
- Learn to prepare choreography and organize a dance show
  - Experience what it is like to perform in a professional setting
  - Explore different genres of dance through choreography both taught and created
  - Learn to organize and feel comfortable leading and executing outreach activities

**Reading Component:** Dance terminology, performance/staging directions, timelines, connecting Bible truths to practical life applications

**Writing Component:** Encouragement through notes/letters, reflections, journaling,

## Description:

We will spend a few days leading up to our flight to Disney preparing our dance performance by choreographing pieces, editing music, organizing costuming and performance schedules, preparing outreach gifts, etc. We will then fly to Orlando where we will spend 5 nights at Disney's Caribbean Beach Resort. During one of these days we will be performing in the park. There will be two days where we can enjoy the park and 2 days will be spent on the resort where we will be handing out small gifts and letters of encouragement to the staff and praying with or over them.

Every morning (even before we leave) will begin with devotions as a group, personal and group prayer time, and a life applicable Bible principle for the day. From there we will move on to the "to do" list for that day (choreography, choosing music, performing, outreach). As we close down each night, we will finish with team building games, a share time and journaling and closing prayer.

## This course is well suited to:

Students who enjoy dancing or performing arts. Dance experience is not mandatory but is helpful. Choreography will be worked to include all dance levels/abilities.

Students who are accepted will be required to begin working on and learning choreography prior to intercession. It is expected that it will take around 5 practice sessions to put the performance pieces together.
