Senior Yearbook Portraits

The following guidelines will assist a senior and his/her photographer in submitting an appropriate photograph:

- 1. The portrait shall be of the graduating senior <u>only</u>. Appropriate props, as defined by the yearbook advisor, will be allowed.
- 2. The portrait must be a 2"X3" vertical, color picture. For head and shoulder portraits, the head must not exceed 1 ¹/₄" from the chin to the top of the hair.
- 3. Portraits must be submitted by October 1st. The Yearbook staff will retain the right to make the final selection of the picture to be published and notify seniors no later than October 15.
- 4. Any senior will have the right to appeal the decision of the Yearbook staff by submitting a letter to the adviser no later than October 20. The regular appeal process will be followed.
