

## **Rowland Hall - Bus Rules – 2021–2022 School Year**

- 1) The bus is an extension of the classroom. All Rowland Hall school rules and expectations apply to all students while riding a Rowland Hall bus. Please see the parent/student handbook for school rules and expectations.**
  - 2) Students are expected to follow the driver's and monitor's instructions the first time asked.**
  - 3) Students are expected to show respect toward adults, other students, and school bus property.**
  - 4) Students must wear properly fastened seat belts at all times.**
  - 5) Students are expected to sit in their seats and face forward while the bus is in motion.**
  - 6) Students are expected to talk quietly, using appropriate language.**
  - 7) Students are expected to keep hands, feet, and objects to themselves and inside the bus. Students must never throw anything out of bus windows.**
  - 8) Food, gum, and drinks are not permitted on the bus. Students may eat a snack before boarding the bus. Drinking water on the bus is acceptable.**
  - 9) Electronic devices are allowed while riding the bus but must be on silent or vibrate. Any media must be played through headphones and not through speakers.**
  - 10) Students are not allowed to take photos or record videos while on the bus.**
  - 11) Electronic devices are not allowed on field trips during school hours.**

### **2021–2022 Bus Rules Acknowledgement**

**If a child is not following the above guidelines, the following consequences will occur.**

The initial infraction will be an opportunity to dialogue with the student about their inappropriate behavior. The student(s) will receive a warning and be advised to change their behavior.

If the inappropriate behavior continues after the initial warning, parents will be contacted. Consequences for continuing and/or serious infractions may include loss of bus privileges.
