



## SCHOOL SUPPLIES AND CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

### School Supplies

Being prepared on the first day of school is important to the organization process, therefore we request the following school supplies are purchased over the summer and brought on the first day of school, Thursday, September 2<sup>nd</sup>. *We are asking students to only use their own school supplies.*

- Trapper keeper – zipper binder, 8½” x 11” with three 2” binder rings
- 3 three-hole durable pocket holders
- iPad or laptop (see Technology letter)

TSS will provide each student with:

- Zipper pencil holder
- 3 pencils
- 3 different color highlighters
- 1 multi-colored ink pen
- 1 large eraser
- 1 box of colored pencils
- 1 ruler
- 1 glue stick
- 1 pair scissors
- 1 assignment pad

Teachers will assist students in organizing and labeling their folders according to their schedule on the first day of school.

### Co-Curricular Activities

Students will have one co-curricular class each day, Monday through Friday. They will have either Art, Music, SEL (Social and Emotional Learning), Health and Wellness, or a PE class embedded within their day. *Students do not need a change of clothing for any of these co-curriculars.* They will attend these classes in dress code and sneakers. Girls should wear “biker” or “undershorts” beneath their skirt or dress if they do not wear shorts or pants on their assigned PE days.

If your child has an injury that prevents them from participating in PE, a doctor’s note must be provided to your child’s Advisor explaining the injury, restrictions, and the day(s) they will not be able to participate.
