2) Meeting Minutes from October 14, 2019—Minutes approved with edits

3) Review of LISD Vision Statement, Mission Statement, Goals and Objectives and Operational Procedures

- Current Operational Procedures state that first meeting would be held in October, members would like to remove this start month
- Members discussed Board of Trustees appointment of members. Executive Committee to present a membership roster to the Board of Trustees for approval and appointment.
- A question was brought up about Quorum. We will get more information about this and discuss at next meeting.

4) Emergency Preparedness in Lockhart ISD—Presented by Kimberly Brents

- LISD has a safety task force team that includes Police Department, DPS, Caldwell County Sherriff's office, Fire and Rescue, LISD Health Services Coordinator, LISD Social-Emotional Learning Counselor, LISD Executive Director or Communications and Community Services and the LISD Deputy Superintendent.
- Senate Bill 11 mandates that each District form a threat assessment team which we already have
- House Bill 496 mandates for school districts to develop a traumatic injury response protocol which includes having bleeding control kits available on campus. The District will have "Stop the Bleed" kits by each AED and also will have a tourniquet available in each room where students are. Staff will be trained to use the bleeding control kits.
- All LISD staff, substitutes and student teachers have received CRASE training (Civilian Response to Active Shooter Events). This is an annual training.
- The District will be implementing School Guard 911. This is an app that can be used by staff to report an armed intruder, call 911 or request assistance. In the event of an armed intruder, an alert will go out to all law enforcement in the area. Also, staff will be able to see the area where the armed intruder is located in the school.

5) Membership Input

- LISD will be hosting our first Parent University at Plum Creek on January 23rd. There will be sessions that parents can attend about different topics like anxiety, bullying, setting limits, stress management, vaping, attendance.
- On February 14th, staff have an in-service day and will have training on Trauma Informed Care.
