

Things look to be heating up in our week ahead! It looks as if after this chilly past week that Spring may have sprung!






- 1. Call your school's attendance line to report your student's absence.

- 3. Contact your health care provider for next steps.



*Symptoms of COVID-19



- Cough
- Shortness of breath or Sore throat difficulty breathing
- Fever equal to or greater than 100.4°F
- Chills
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Diarrhea
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting


