



Congratulations on your acceptance to Next Level Nola! NLN is a great opportunity to get a jump start on your college, career, and future goals. NLN presents fellows with wonderful opportunities. In order to take advantage of these opportunities, you must complete your enrollment meeting and attend summer orientation. Below are some FAQs about the application process.

1. I've been accepted to Next Level Nola, what's next?

In order to be officially enrolled at NLN, you must attend an enrollment meeting and summer orientation.

2. When do I start Next Level Nola?

At your enrollment meeting, you will sign up for one of three options for orientation. Each orientation session will be one week long (Monday-Friday from 10am-2pm). Orientation will introduce you to the NLN staff, your cohort, and what you can expect at NLN. The three orientation dates will be (1) July 26-30 (2) August 2-6 or (3) August 16-20. The first day of classes will start on August 25, 2021.

3. What will my schedule be like?

You will receive your official schedule during orientation. Your schedule will be determined by the pathway you choose.

If you choose the trade or IT pathway, you will be required to attend classes specific to your pathway. If you choose a college pathway, you can expect to have at least 2 mandatory classes each week to support you in your college work.

For all pathways, there will be supplemental classes offered (Real World Learning, Adulting, Power Skills, and ACT Prep). You will be expected to attend 4 hours of Learning Lab for every class that you are enrolled in (similar to study hall) and one meeting with your Success Coach each week. Lastly, there may also be additional events throughout the year.

4. If I have to attend summer school, am I still eligible for the Next Level Nola fellowship?

You may still be eligible for the NLN fellowship if you are attending summer school. In order to remain eligible, you must pass your summer school classes and meet all graduation requirements before August 2021.

5. What is an enrollment meeting?

An enrollment meeting is a meeting at the NLN office ([1340 Poydras Street, Suite 1600](#)) that will allow you to reserve your seat. During the meeting, you will sign your official intent to enroll form, learn more about the NLN fellowship, and meet NLN staff. You will also sign up for summer orientation, have an opportunity to ask questions about NLN, and complete other documentation. *An enrollment meeting is required in order to*



participate in the NLN fellowship, and you must come in person to the office for the meeting. [Here](#) is a link to the letter you received about your enrollment meeting.

6. When are enrollment meetings and where can I sign up?

You may schedule a 45-minute meeting on calendly [here](#). Summer dates remaining to complete your enrollment meeting are July 27th, July 28th, August 4th, August 10th, August 11th, and August 12th.

7. What should I bring to an enrollment meeting?

Please remember to bring a copy of your high school transcript, a state or school ID (if you have one), a copy of your birth certificate, and proof of residency (any bill/govt agency mailed to your home address).

8. Where should I park for my enrollment meeting?

There is free visitor parking for 1 hour next to Orleans Tower ([1340 Poydras Street, Suite 1600](#)). You must sign in at the front desk so that your vehicle is not booted.

9. I was signed up for an enrollment meeting and I missed it. What should I do?
