HAPPY INDEPENDENCE DAY! — Despite what the calendar says, it seems summer really begins on the 4th of July. That's when we experience fireworks in the street or on the Mall in Washington DC. That's when we gather with family and friends, and when we stage cookouts and barbecues in the backyard, and probably drink a lot of cold beverages. Amidst all the red, white, and blue celebration, let's not forget what this day commemorates. Wishing you a happy Fourth!

REFLECTING ON LOSS – Recently, within a short span of only a few weeks, I lost four long-time friends – the kind you have for 40 or 50 years. Irreplaceable. They all lived to a good age, so I can't say they were called home too soon. Nobody likes to think about death. Yes, we know it's inevitable, but our minds push it away and we hear that little inside voice saying "Yeah, some day, but not yet!" That is, until we experience the loss of someone very special, forcing us to face our own mortality. But when a tsunami of loss occurs in such a short time, and the circle of friends we've had from the past suddenly shrinks dramatically, it seems much worse.

As I've written before, and as many of you know, my mom

lived to be 102. When the very last, long-time friend from her circle of comfort and support for so many years died, she began to refer to herself as "The Last of the Mohicans." It always made us laugh. It's appropriate that she chose that title, because she always was a warrior—determined, going hard at whatever life brought, and more than able to tackle whatever came into her days. Another way she'd refer to herself was as "a tough old bird." Yes, she was that too. I'm beginning to understand where she was coming from.

While grieving the loss of Don, Doris, Betty and Jo, I see the number of friends from the back side of my life getting smaller each year but at the same time, on the front side I can see the many new friends I've made in the three years since I moved into my retirement community. No, they'll never be like the forty- and fifty-year-old relationships that I've lost, but they fill my days with laughter, compassion and warmth. Best of all, however, are the memories that sustain me and, together, the old and the new become enough.
