Dear LES families,

Wow! While the start to this school year has been different, it has been amazing, too! Students are settling in and adjusting well to our new safety procedures and protocols. As some of you may know, a major renovation has been in the works for LES for quite some time. Well, that time is now! The project has been approved, and construction will begin in late September/early October. Please see the list below for what the renovation will entail:

- New HVAC system throughout the building
- New flooring and paint throughout (blue accent walls in classrooms)
- New cabinetry/storage in classrooms
- Water fountains replaced with purified refilling stations
- New data cabling/WLES (morning announcements) upgrade
- Digital clocks throughout the building and New Promethean Boards
- Redesigned storage area in the gym
- New cabinetry, floors, and paint in the teacher work/lunch area
- Completely renovated kitchen in the cafeteria

The renovation is projected to take around 22 months to complete. Because the work will be done while we are in school, a phasing plan will be in place. The renovation will take place in phases, and the plan will allow teachers to move to a temporary classrooms while their classroom is being renovated. Each phase is estimated to take about 2 months to complete. I will be involved in monthly construction meetings and will keep you updated throughout the process. While we may have some “growing pains” during the process, we believe it will be well worth it. Our school will be beautiful when it is complete!
