



REMOTE LEARNING MODEL

The Remote Learning option is available for K-8th grade students, choosing a virtual learning experience for the 21-22 school year. English language arts, math, science, and social studies classes are taught by certified Liberty District teachers trained in online instruction. Liberty teachers will deliver regular and responsive live and recorded instruction to students in an online environment, as well as offer support and feedback through ongoing assessment and virtual meetings.

SYNCHRONOUS LIVE INSTRUCTION

Teachers will deliver instruction for 60-120 minutes at scheduled times during the day, for students to interact live with the teacher and other students in whole group and small groups as well as one on one.




ASYNCHRONOUS INDEPENDENT PACE

Students will also flexibly complete assignments in both Google Classroom and Edgenuity. Lessons are aligned to Liberty curriculum guides. Edgenuity will provide digital instructional resources designed specifically for online learning. Students will be able to access their learning in Edgenuity at any time or day, at their own pace by actively listening to video-recorded lessons that they can stop and start to complete interactive lessons.

Other Supports for Children

Parent Expectation/Role

- Participate in required parent training
- Provide a learning space and environment for students to work
- Provide basic technology support to child
- (K-3 ONLY) - Serve as a K-3 Primary Learning Facilitator (aka Learning Coach) to guide children through each lesson, monitor and facilitate the learning experience, and assist with logging into scheduled Google Meet sessions and Edgenuity courses and modules.
 - Review listed prerequisite skills in the Learning Coach tab
 - Read the lesson objectives
 - Prepare any needed materials
 - Discuss what is being taught
 - Facilitate hands-on learning
- Preview resources necessary to facilitate learning (K-3)
- Evaluate child's progress at 25-day milestone for continued enrollment in Remote Learning model
- Regularly check email/Edgenuity parent portal to monitor student instructional minutes and progress toward completion of courses
- Communicate with the teacher
- Communicate with online support system as needed
- Access ParentVue to view progress report and trimester grades



STUDENT EXPECTATIONS

- Participate in scheduled required student training/orientation (increased synchronous schedule first week of school)
- Attend daily scheduled Google Meet (Whole group and small group) learning sessions
- Complete assigned daily course work in Edgenuity and Google Classroom
- Participate in scheduled individual check in's with teacher
- Participate in district and state benchmark and end-of-year assessments in person at the school (calendar to be provided)
