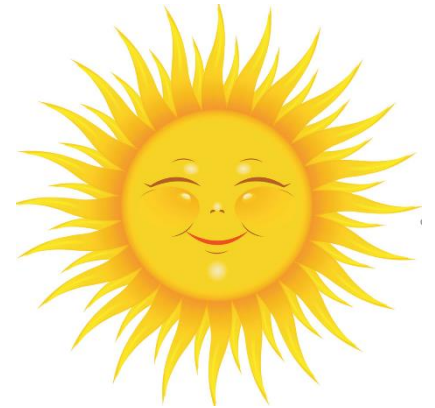

## Y7 – Y13 Live Careers Expos- 8 and 15 July

LearnLive are hosting their biggest Careers LIVE Expo of 2021 on the Learn Live Channel on 8 and 15 July. Around 500 employers from a range of different sectors will be participating and available to answer your questions, e.g. what work experience do I need to become an engineer? Do you have any placements available? What subjects should I take to become a physiotherapist?



The Expos will take place from 9am-7pm. Employer videos will run continuously and pupils and parents are encouraged to take part and speak directly with hundreds of different companies from a wide range of sectors via the LIVE chat function.

### Drafting application materials
