



ONLINE REGISTRATION FOR ATHLETICS

The Chaska High School Athletics Department is excited to continue our support with online registration for the 2021-22 academic year. Chaska High School offers over 30 different athletics programs designed to meet the interests of our student body. These programs are an opportunity and a privilege afforded to students in our Chaska school community. Students are strongly encouraged to become active in a variety of activities while attending Chaska High School.

PURPOSE OF ATHLETICS

Chaska High School recognizes the value and importance of our athletics programs as an extension of a good educational program. Participation in our athletics programs is a privilege and a valuable part of the overall school experience. It contributes to the emotional, physical, and intellectual development of our students, helping prepare them to become productive, contributing citizens of their community.

BELIEFS

- Athletics is part of our educational program. It should be FUN!
- Athletics must teach positive values: fair play, good sportsmanship, pride in self, team and school community.
- Participation in athletics is important. Multi-sport participation is encouraged and supported.

- Athletics should encourage athletes to stretch beyond their comfort zone, taking risks within a structured environment.
- Athletics enhances physical and mental well-being.
- Meaningful competition is healthy.
- A sound athletics program stimulates participants to win and excel, recognizing our purpose is human growth and potential.

- Our school community is stronger when we promote healthy relationships through respect for opponents, officials, teammates, self, and for persons in position of authority.

Our Chaska Hawks compete in the Metro West Conference and are members of the Minnesota State High School League. Chaska High School has won 195 Conference Championships, participated in over 205 State Tournaments, and has won State Championships in Boys' Basketball, Girls' Basketball, Dance Team, Football, Girls' Golf, Adapted Softball, and Volleyball!

We have transitioned to a new Athletics online registration portal, so each student/family will need to go through a couple steps prior to completing online registration.

- Step 1: Create a **PARENT** user account and then connect to your student(s) record(s) by their Student ID number and Date of Birth. Here is a link to information on this process.

These same links are available on the homepage of our online registration portal. If you are having issues creating a parent account, connecting to your student(s) profiles, and/or registering, please contact the Chaska Athletics Office. If your student is new to Eastern Carver County Schools, for the 2021-22 school year, you first need to contact the Chaska Athletics Office so a student profile can be created within the registration system.

A “Special Consideration” option will continue to be a registration option during each season. A reminder that this registration option should be used by families who qualify for free/reduced services, experiencing financial hardship, and/or registering as Team Manager. The “Special Consideration” registration option allows families to complete the required online registration steps, but not have a credit card charged at completion of registration. This registration option can also be used by families when they meet the individual and/or family cap.

The Minnesota State High School League (MSHSL) requires all registered student-athlete participants to have a sports qualifying physical on file with the Chaska Athletics Office. A sports qualifying physical is good for three calendar years, from the date of physical, as signed by physician. Once the three-year physical date expires, the student-athlete must submit an updated sports physical to begin/continue athletic participation. For example, if your date of physical was August 16, 2019, that physical would be good through August 16, 2022. Students who do not have a sports qualifying physical on file and/or have a physical on file that doesn't meet this three-year clearance, will be required to have an updated physical on file with the Chaska Athletics office prior to any participation clearance. **If a student needs an updated physical, the 2021-22 MSHSL Sports Qualifying Physical form is available on the registration homepage under “Resources”.** This form should be printed off and brought to your scheduled exam for the physician to complete. Once completed, this form can be emailed as attachment and/or delivered to the Chaska High School Athletics Office so student profile can be updated. In the event you plan to deliver, please make sure you coordinate with athletics office staff due to summer office hours.

It is recommended that all registration be completed at least two (2) weeks prior to the start of the season. Students should be completely registered by the Friday preceding the official MSHSL start date. Student-athletes will not be allowed to participate and/or try-out for a sport without being fully registered and cleared by the Chaska Athletics Office. Students are eligible to register early for winter and spring season sport offerings, but doing so are eligible to receive a sticker on their student ID allowing “free” attendance at home District 112 events.

If you were not a full-time student throughout the duration of the 2020-21 school year in a District 112 building (Chaska High School, Chaska Middle School East, Chaska Middle School West, Pioneer Ridge Middle School), please contact Jon Summer (Assistant Principal/Athletic Director) to verify MSHSL transfer status. This includes incoming foreign exchange students.

Parents/Guardians and Students: Please review the eligibility information very carefully. Students who are new to District 112 and/or Chaska High School, including foreign exchange students, must take special care in properly registering. If you have any questions regarding eligibility, please ask. Your student's eligibility affects the entire school district and community.

Please note:

- There will be no exceptions to the sports qualifying physical examination requirement. Must have a sports qualifying physical, that meets clearance date requirements, on file prior to any participation/tryout.
- Sports qualifying physical can be emailed to LentzB@District112.org
- Any paperwork must be turned in to the Chaska High School Athletics Office. Please do not bring paperwork to your first practice and/or tryout.
- **Financial Assistance** is available. Please email SummerJ@District112.org for more information. You can also call 952-556-7135.
- Refunds will be given if your son/daughter does not make a team. This applies to programs that conduct tryouts.
- Make sure the doctor signs and dates your physical before leaving the doctor's office.
- 7-8 grade students participating in 7-12 programs must register at Chaska High School. If you are a 7-8 grade student looking to participate/tryout in a 9-12 program, you must contact the Head Coach to confirm participation.
- If you are a 7-8 grade student participating in a program that is a cooperative (Chaska/Chanhassen StormHawks), you must register with your assigned/boundary high school.
- Chaska Athletics will continue to provide “stickers” on student ID’s for students/families that have finalized registration for fall, winter, and/or spring sports seasons. This sticker will provide “free” access to District 112 regular season events. For example, if you register for spring Track & Field, your student can bring their student ID to Chaska Athletics office to receive a sticker that they show at home District 112 events and will be provided “free” admission.
