Payment of Fees

Place a check mark next to each fee you will be paying for your student. This will speed up the processing of your payment at the Fee Station.

- \$22.00 Registration Fee** (Required) - This fee covers the partial cost of a student planner, assembly programs, towel services for Physical Education and some team-sponsored activities. **(This fee should not be confused with the Athletic User Fee of \$30.00.)**

- _____ **\$8.00 Physical Education Shirt** - This shirt is required for Physical Education. Shirts purchased in previous years can be worn.

- _____ **\$6.00 Lock** - This lock is for your Physical Education locker. Students must purchase a lock from the Physical Education Department to be used at John Muir. Locks purchased from John Muir in previous years can be used, and the same lock can be used at West High School.

- _____ **\$4.00 - 7th & 8th Grade Family Consumer Science Materials Fee** -
Fee is per semester.

- _____ **\$4.00 - 7th Grade Tech Apps or 8th Manufacturing Class Fee** -
Fee is per semester.

- _____ **\$25.00 Yearbook** (Optional) - This covers the cost of a yearbook which is distributed at the end of the school year. There will be other times to purchase yearbooks during the school year.

- _____ **\$20.00 - Chromebook Insurance** (Optional) - Coverage is renewed each school year.

Please calculate your child's needs and have the funds ready for payment (**cash** or **check** made out to **John Muir Middle School**). An additional fee will be assessed for NSF checks returned to us from our bank. *Please note we are not equipped to accept on-site credit or debit card payments at this time.* **If you have pre-paid fees using the Online Payments option in the Parent Portal of Infinite Campus, please bring a copy of your receipt for verification.**

You will receive a fee payment receipt which you will present to pick up your student's schedule. Schedules will not be issued unless the minimum \$22.00 registration fee is paid or other arrangements have been made **in advance** by calling the Office of the Principal (715-261-0101).

After paying fees, you will visit the other stations to pick up materials. Please use this handy checklist to make sure you pick up everything your student may need.

Shirt and Lock Pick Up - If a Physical Education shirt or lock is purchased, you may pick up the item at this table by providing your fee payment receipt.

Nutrition Services Program - The Wausau School District Nutrition Services will continue to offer free meals to all students through June 30, 2022. School menus will be posted on the district website closer to the start of the 2021-2022 school year. Ala carte options will be available at John Muir with the requirement of a positive meal account balance at the time of purchase. Money should be placed in lunch accounts with checks made out to **Wausau School District Food Service**. Any money left in an account from last school year will be transferred to this school year. For the 2021-2022 school year, the USDA is asking that **all families complete and submit a Free & Reduced Meal Application** either online or by paper before school starts. This form is the only method that the government has to determine funding for several of the educational programs within the school district. The online form is available on the WSD website (www.wausauschools.org - Nutrition Services - Free & Reduced Meal Application), and paper forms will be available at Schedule Pick Up.

Transportation Information - First Student will contact rural bus riders. Passes and route sheets will be issued for city bus riders through MetroRide. Students riding the city bus can buy bus tickets and get route schedules. You must purchase 10 tickets for \$9.50, or a monthly unlimited-rides pass may be purchased for \$21.00. **Checks should be made out to MetroRide. An application for free bus tickets must be completed at this time. Eligibility for these free tickets is based on distance from your residence to John Muir (2+ miles) and not the resources to purchase tickets.**
