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## English Language Development Services (ELD)

Service Offered	Description
<p><b>Assessment</b></p>	<p>Services are available to evaluate student English language proficiency and support the need for English language development. Assessments are available to calculate the language acquisition progress of the English learner and as one of the measures to determine eligibility for ELD program exit.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• ACCESS 2.0 or Alternate ACCESS 2.0</li> <li>• W-APT</li> <li>• MODEL</li> <li>• Woodcock-Munoz Revised Language Survey</li> <li>• Student Observation</li> <li>• Portfolio Assessment</li> </ul>
<p><b>Direct Instruction</b></p>	<p>Direct instruction includes research-based instructional strategies that follow a planned course for English language development. Instruction provided individually or in small groups on a regular schedule determined collaboratively by the ELD Supervisor, ELD teacher and the district staff.</p> <p>This service provides teaching materials and access to a database, developed and maintained by CAIU, to track state-required information on demographics and achievement, and support in content subjects as needed. The CAIU Supervisor oversees all aspects of the program, including on-site supervision and evaluation of the ELD teacher.</p>
<p><b>ESL Programmatic Consultation &amp; Professional Development</b></p>	<p>Consultation and professional development services are available and designed to meet individual needs. Among others, these services may include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Program compliance with state and federal ESL requirements</li> <li>• Content/Grade level teacher training in ESL best practices/collaborative teaching</li> <li>• Language difference versus learning disability consultations</li> <li>• Integrating ESL instruction into MTSS</li> </ul>

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
