Supporting Harbor Country Day School

The Harbor Fund: The Harbor Fund is an annual fundraising campaign that directly supports Harbor Country Day School's (HCDS) programs – and your children – in an academic year. It is necessary because tuition income is not enough to cover HCDS's annual expenses. In fact, nearly one-third of school expenses are not covered by tuition and must be funded through other means, such as the Harbor Fund. Parents, alumni, trustees, faculty, staff and friends are all asked to contribute.

The Campaign For Harbor Country: Harbor Country Day School's decades-long history of academic rigor and innovation makes us who we are. Our mission and core values have driven our success through the years, from maintaining day-to-day school operations to fueling rapid growth. At all times, those values have shaped the extraordinary experiences cherished by every student who has walked the halls of Tulip Knoll.

The Campaign for Harbor Country Day School is an ambitious \$10 million capital campaign which has two primary goals:

- The first is to raise \$6.5 million for the school's Endowment which supports faculty, tuition assistance and general operating needs.
- The second is to raise \$3.5 million for the modernization of Harbor Country Day's campus and physical plant which will include a state-of-the-art STEAM center and new facilities for classrooms and in-school community spaces.

With this campaign, which is unlike anything the school has seen in its 62-year history, Harbor Country Day School is poised to become the premier independent elementary school on Long Island.
