

HOW TO PREPARE FOR PARTICIPATION

Students have the choice of whether or not to participate in the Restorative Justice Process. Should a student choose to participate, students can help make this a constructive process by doing the following:

- Think about the offense, what happened, what it has meant to you, and how you feel about it now.
- Be prepared to tell the victim what happened, to share your feelings and answer questions about the offense and listen to what the offense has meant to them.
- Be sure that you know the time and place of the arranged meeting. It is very important that everyone be at the meeting at the agreed time. If you cannot attend, let the volunteer facilitator know as soon as possible.
