MINUTES DAVIE COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION TUESDAY, JUNE 1, 2021

The Davie County Board of Education met at 4:00 p.m., June 1, 2021, in the Board Room of the Central Davie Education Center, 220 Martin Luther King Jr. Road, Mocksville, NC.

Chairman Junker called the meeting to order at 4:00 p.m. Chairman Junker offered the invocation then led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Paul Drechsler made the motion, seconded by David Carroll, to adopt the agenda as presented. The motion carried 7-0.

Paul Drechsler made the motion, seconded by Lori Smith, to approve the minutes of the May 4, 2021 regular Board of Education meeting as presented. The motion carried 7-0.

Board Report

Chairman Junker reviewed upcoming events starting with Central Davie Academy's graduation on June 3rd at 11:00 a.m. Friday, June 4, 2021 will be the last day for students in Davie County Schools; there will be an early release this day as well. Davie County High School will hold graduation Saturday, June 5 at 8:30 a.m. in the War Eagle Stadium. The next Board of Commissioners Meeting will be Monday, June 7, 2021 at 6:00 p.m. The next Board of Education meeting will be Tuesday, July 6, 2021 with a start time of 4:00 p.m. and closed session at the end of the meeting.

Superintendent's Report

Mr. Wallace began by stating the end of school is almost here. Congratulations to the Davie County Early College High School students who graduated on Saturday, May 22, 2021. There will be close to 360 graduates at the Davie County High School graduation this Saturday, June 5, 2021.

Davie County's Summer School extension plan was approved; students will attend summer school from June 21-July 15, 2021. The Summer School is fully staffed and is expecting around 730 students to attend.

Davie County School's projected enrollment for 2021-2022 is 6,041 students. Currently, total enrollment is at 5,812 students. Mr. Wallace stated the difference could be Kindergarteners returning to school who made the decision back in August 2020 to wait one year until they start school. At this point, enrollment is comparable to previous years prior to COVID-19. Attendance records at this time during the 2018-2019 school year was at 95.24%; we are currently at an attendance rate of 93.44%.

Mr. Wallace stated the ESSER II (\$3.6 million) and ESSER III (\$8 million) funds were both recently approved for Davie County Schools. That is a total of \$11.6 million that Davie County Schools plans to spend on staffing, facilities, and learning loss.

Mr. Wallace explained he has already had a meeting with his reopening team from this school year regarding communication about next school year. Davie County Schools have already started to receive mask exemptions for rising Kindergarteners. As of today, there is no protocol for the 2021-2022 school year.

Davie County Schools may hold a vaccine clinic late July 2021 for those staff and students who choose to take the vaccine with the second dose being before school starts late August. Mr. Wallace said it is possible that children under 12 years old could be approved for the vaccine and it be available to those who choose to take it September or October of this year.

Mr. Wallace ended with recognizing Character Education awards at each school.

Recognitions

A PowerPoint was presented with each Character Education winner's picture and name from each school.

Mr. Jesse Ledbetter presented awards to the Future Farmers of America group at Davie County High School. Bailey Dyson placed 1st in the Region, 1st in the State, and received National Recognition for FFA Prepared Parliamentary Procedure. Bailey also placed 1st in the State for FFA Diversified Livestock Production and 1st place in the Region for FFA Prepared Public Speaking. The DCHS FFA Chapter was a National Chapter Award Winner with Two Stars. The FFA Dairy Judging Team placed 1st in the Region; team members included Bailey Dyson, Nathan Haskin, Riley Crotts, and Addison Hendrix. The FFA Floriculture Team placed 1st in the Region; team members included Nathan Haskin, Kasey Williford, Addison Hendrix, and Riley Crotts.

Mr. Andrew Jimeson presented Hazel Marion with the NC All State Band pin. Hazel Marion was selected as 2nd Chair Flute in the 9th-10th grade NC All State Honor Symphonic Band.

Mr. Doyle Nicholson introduced Ms. Tani Caudle and the DCHS Mock Trial Team. The DCHS Mock Trial Team won the North Carolina Advocates for Justice 2021 State Championship with their performances at the March 5 and 6, 2021 competition. Team members included: Jackson Trivette, Ethan Page, Luca Iacopi, Zeb Chapman, Aiden Booth, Ashley Tatem, Owen Fender, Caden Coble, and Emma Green. Attorney Advisors for the team were Judge Carlton Terry and Wendy Terry.

Mr. Mike Absher and Mr. Doyle Nicholson introduced Shane Nixon, DCHS Men's Tennis Team Coach. The Men's Tennis Team at DCHS tied for 1st place as conference champions in the Central Piedmont Conference. The team members included: Luke Stillson, C Crenshaw, Jack Nixon, Cren Rosenbaum, Burke Rosenbaum, Bryce Bailey, Seth Hill, Cooper Smith, Slade Keaton, Jack Williams, Jackson Clark, and Owen Fender. Burke Rosenbaum was selected as the Central Piedmont Conference Men's Tennis Player of the Year.

Ms. Morgan Wyatt, Softball Coach for DCHS, introduced London Dirks who was selected as the Central Piedmont Conference Softball Player of the Year.

Consent Agenda

Cammie Webb made the motion, seconded by Lori Smith, to approve the consent items as presented. The motion carried 7-0. Consent items approved: School Nutrition Contract Extensions for 2021-2022, Career and Technical Education Local Application for 2021-2022, Alternative School Modified Accountability Model, Donations Report, Surplus Property Report, Budget Amendments, Public School Building Capital Fund NC Education Lottery-CZE and DCHS, Resolution Granting Authority to the Superintendent and Chief Financial Officer to Implement June 2021 Budget Amendments, FY 2021-2022 Continuing Budget Resolution, FY 2021-2022 Capital Outlay Budget Resolution, Personnel Recommendations, Summer Employment/Teacher Contracts.

Business Items

Mrs. Jennifer Custer, Mrs. Jinda Haynes, Ms. Jennifer Kacerek, and Mrs. Andreia Collins presented the School Based Mental Health Policy Plan. The State Board of Education met on November 5, 2020 and adopted Policy SHLT-003: School Based Mental Health Initiative. This policy requires each public school unit to adopt and to implement a School Based Mental Health Plan that includes a mental health training program and a suicide risk referral protocol. Dub Potts made the motion to approve the SHLT-003: School Based Mental Health Policy Plan as presented. Paul Drechsler seconded the motion; the motion carried 7-0.

Public Address to the Board

Attorney Jill Wilson explained the procedures for public comments. One individual signed up to speak before the board. That person was allowed five minutes to speak.

1. Joann Landry-Ms. Landry wanted to know if the Critical Race Theory was being discussed in Davie County. Are parents being surveyed regarding Critical Race Theory? Are there stipulations on the COVID monies being received? Will there be a vaccination mandate in Davie County or in Davie County Schools? Are there any schools with 5G network towers? Ms. Landry requests a policy be created, where parents can access it, to hold teachers accountable for what they teach as there are political agendas in Davie County that Ms. Landry wants stopped.

Committee and Staff Reports

Mr. Wallace presented the Spring Policy updates for the board to look over during the month of June. These policies will be presented for approval at the July 7, 2021 Board of Education meeting.

Mr. Clay Harris gave a review of the approved ESSER funds and the requirements and plans to use those funds. Davie County Schools are required to spend a minimum of 20% of the funds on learning loss. Davie County Schools are required to develop an opening plan with stakeholders of the school system. Expenditures must be allowable, reasonable, and necessary.

Mr. Jimmie Welch and Mrs. Lori Smith reviewed what the Hunger Fighters group did this school year during a pandemic. Hunger Fighters received a \$54,000 grant from Larson Doors in Mocksville, NC. Mr. Welch mentioned spending the money on an access drive to the loading area at DCHS and a box truck to be used for food pick-up and deliveries. A video was shown with pictures of Hunger Fighters events with free food for students and food bags that went home with students during the pandemic.

Mrs. Valerie Feezor, Principal of Davie County Virtual School, gave an update on enrollment in the Virtual School. Currently, 56 students have been accepted between the grades of 4-8 and 57 students have been accepted between the grades of 9-12. Those 113 students have been actively involved with Mrs. Feezor by giving ideas for school mascots, school colors, etc. Mrs. Feezor has already received interest from 6 parents to be on a parent advisory team for Davie County Virtual School. There is a waitlist for students of new families to Davie County so they don't miss out on this opportunity.

Ms. Dana Roberts, art teacher at South Davie Middle School, shared the virtual world of Arts Smart 2021 that Will Marrs and John Marshall helped create.

Closed Session

Chairman Junker called for a motion to go into closed session to preserve the attorney client privilege pursuant to N.C.G.S. 143-318.11(a)(3) to discuss personnel matters protected by State law and N.C.G.S.143-318.11(a)(6); to discuss student matters made confidential by N.C.G.S. 143-318.11(a)(1), G.S. 115C-402 and FERPA. David Carroll made the motion, seconded by Lori Smith; the motion carried 7-0. The Board went into closed session at 6:09 p.m.

Return to Open Session

The board returned from closed session to open session at 6:50 p.m.

The Public School Laws of North Carolina Article 31, Part 2, Section 115C-425(a) requires that "each local school administrative unit shall operate under an annual balanced budget resolution ..." Section 115C-441(a) requires that "... no obligation may be incurred by a local school administrative unit unless the budget resolution includes an appropriation authorizing the obligation and an unencumbered balance remains in the appropriation sufficient to pay in the current fiscal year the sums obligated by the transaction for the current fiscal year."

The Board of Education authorizes the Superintendent and Chief Financial Officer to implement June budget amendments for the close-out of fiscal year 2020-2021 as long as the amendments do not exceed \$750,000 per single line item.

A report of any and all budget amendments authorized by the Superintendent and Chief Financial Officer will be presented to the Board of Education at the July 2021 monthly meeting.

- b. Amounts may be transferred not to exceed three percent of the total budget between functions of the same fund with a report of such transfers being required at the next meeting of the Board of Education.
- c. Amounts may not be transferred between funds nor from any contingency appropriation within a fund.

Copies of the Budget Resolution shall be immediately furnished to the superintendent and the school finance officer for direction in carrying out their duties.
