## What's New in Service Tracker



### **One-Time Consent Received:**

To see if your district has received a student's One-Time Parental Consent form, click on the magnifying glass in the banner under the student's demographic information. This will bring up a pop-up box that will let you know if the consent has been received or not.

Remember, consent must be received in order to bill for Medicaid.

This information is no longer displayed next to the student's placement information.



## Ask Medicaid Man



**Dear Medicaid Man,**

**I am a new Case Manager for Medicaid. I was wondering, do I only bill for the student's IEP?**

**~What can I bill?**

Dear Bill,

Planning and holding a student's IEP is only one of many services a Case Manager can bill for.

Here is a **total list** of Medicaid billable Case Management services:

- Assuring re-examination and follow-up activities are conducted
  - Coordinating transition planning meetings

- Contacting services providers regarding student's IEP progress
- Assist families in identifying and choosing providers of care and maintaining contact
  - Linking parents with providers
  - Assist families with questions
- Follow up to ensure student receives diagnostic and treatment services
  - Discussing student progress with service providers
  - Setting up therapy schedule for student (OT, PT, speech, etc)
- Assuring case records are maintained
  - Reviewing, organizing and updating student files CA-60s
  - Updating and collecting student health forms
- Linking and coordinating health services for students
  - Making referrals and scheduling appointments for services like vision/hearing screens, etc.
- Coordinating school based services with parent/guardian
  - Scheduling conference time with parents and providers
  - Attending conferences with parents/family to review IEP progress
- Monitoring and recommending a plan of action
  - Coordinating behavior intervention meetings with team members
- Providing summary of provider, parent, and student consultation
  - Identifying the student's need and completing related documentation

\*Case Managers – remember you can bill for virtual IEPs as you would bill a normal IEP
