


Generate QR Code

Parents must ensure all adults who are authorized to pickup have a PIN. They can setup the parent PIN by logging into the Parent Portal and clicking the [Change PIN] button in the 'My Account' page.


Authorized adults can go to the district specified website to create the QR code.
