Subject: TSSAA Rules Regarding Student Accounts

The Tennessee Secondary School Athletic Association (TSSAA) has specific rules concerning overdue student balances and payment of tuition. We are advising all parents of current and potential student-athletes of these important rules.

Overdue Balances

TSSAA rules state that “schools shall remove from athletic eligibility any student whose accounts with the school are 60 days overdue.” It is vital that all parents of student-athletes be aware of this timeline and that each student’s account is kept current. If an athlete’s account balance is more than 60 days overdue, then that student will be removed from athletic eligibility until the past due balance is paid in full.

Payment of Tuition

TSSAA rules also state that “tuition . . . must be paid by a parent, bona fide guardian, or other family member.” Payment through a trust that is under the control of one of these authorized parties is also acceptable. Webb School cannot accept payment on any athlete’s account by anyone other than those authorized parties as listed, unless approved in advance by the parent. If the parent approves a payment by another source that is not authorized by TSSAA rules, then the student will be removed from athletic eligibility.
