Learning challenge – to be able to recognise a sound that needs to be swapped or removed to make a non-sense word.         Non-sense words are words that are made up – they are 'not real/fake' words.         Using letter cards or writing sounds on individual paper – have a go at building the first word, then use this word to either swap or remove a sound to make a new word.         e.g. I want to change the word cat > mat (I would need to change the 'c' sound into a 'm' sound).
