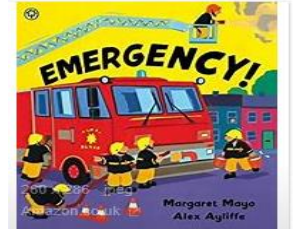




Dear Nursery Parents,

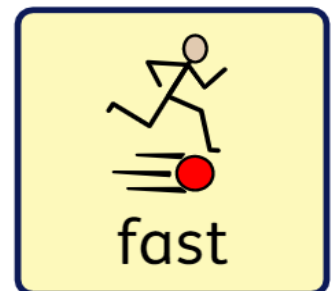
