

Incoming Musicians!

Dear parents of incoming musicians,

Welcome to Blair Academy! My name is Jennifer Pagotto, and I am the school's director of instrumental music. I wanted to take this opportunity to tell you a little bit about our program and to encourage your son or daughter to join one of the instrumental ensembles.

We have two major ensembles at Blair: the Symphony Orchestra and the Jazz Ensemble. These groups embrace students with at least three years of experience playing an instrument. All of the ensembles meet during the academic day and there is no conflict with sports or other after-school activities. Along with Jazz Ensemble, the groups meet for rehearsal four times per week and they are all full-year courses. The ensembles give at least three major concerts per year in addition to off-campus trips and performances. Some vespers services and open houses may also be included. Our music is chosen from the standard orchestral, wind and jazz repertoire, and all of our groups perform at a very high level.

We also have a strong private lesson program at Blair. Students joining the Symphony Orchestra or Jazz Ensemble are strongly encouraged to take private lessons to further enhance their technique and ability with their instrument. These lessons meet once a week during the academic day with teachers from Blair Academy and the surrounding area, and this continued and focused instruction benefits both the student and the group. You may visit our website over the summer for a list of the private teachers.

Included in this packet are two forms: one to register for the instrumental ensembles and one to register for private lessons. Please return the registration forms as soon as possible (but no later than July 15) so that I may begin planning for the size and instrumentation of each ensemble and begin choosing music for next year's concerts. Private Music & Dance Lessons

Private lessons are offered throughout the school year for instruments, voice and dance. Lessons are offered in the first semester (a set of 10 lessons for \$600 or \$650 for violin and piano) and the second semester (a set of 15 lessons for \$900 or \$975 for violin and piano). Instrument rental is available through the department for students who cannot supply their own. In the case of piano, a single fee of \$30.00 or \$45.00 is charged for use of the School's instruments, depending on semester.

Students meet for lessons weekly during the school day, according to their schedule and the teacher's availability. All students are to maintain regular practice schedules, be prompt for lessons, and inform Mrs. Pagotto or their private lessons teacher of potential absences by 6:00 p.m. the evening before.

The first set of lessons runs from the second week of school through the beginning of December. The second set of lessons runs from January through the end of the year. There are no "carryovers" of lessons from one semester to the other, except in the case of extended illness. After the second lesson, there can be no refunds for the remainder of the semester's lessons. In the case of extended illness, lessons may be made up by mutual agreement between the instructor and student. While instructors have some flexibility in their schedules, they are under no obligation to make up multiple unexcused absences. **A reminder: If a student is going to miss a lesson, Mrs. Pagotto or the private lesson teacher must be informed no later than 6:00 p.m. the day before the lesson. We encourage students to enroll for the year, although they may opt not to continue at the close of the first semester. Students **must** notify the director of instrumental music two weeks before the end of the first semester if they do not plan to continue, **and must file an official drop form signed by their monitor.** Lessons are to be paid for in advance (checks may be made payable to Blair Academy). As described in detail in the "fine and performing arts" section of the course catalog, a full school year of lessons may be substituted for one performing art course—though the lessons carry no academic credit. **This option is limited to the junior/senior section of the art requirement AND is available only to four-year students.**
