## Dress Code for Young Women

The young ladies wear either the grey skirt or pants, polo shirt with school emblem, maroon or grey knee socks or tights, school sweater with emblem, and low-top black or brown Eastland tie shoes. Mercy Tech expects the young women to look professional thus hairstyles and makeup should reflect this look. Natural hair color highlights and lowlights are permitted. Skirt:	Gray 2 kick pleat skirt in the front purchased from Flynn
	• The desired skirt length is 1" above the knee and no shorter than three inches above the knee
Dress Pants:	Grey dress pants purchased only from Flynn O'Hara Uniforms
School Shirt:	Short sleeve or long sleeve yellow, maroon, and/or ash gray golf shirt with the school emblem
Sweater:	Maroon and/or Heather Grey Pullover V-Neck/Cardigan Sweater with the school emblem
Shoes:	Low- top Eastlands – Black or Brown - (Positively NO Boots) No Exceptions
	Shoes must be laced and tied; students are not permitted to walk on the back of the shoes
Undershirt:	If worn, white, gray, maroon, yellow – <b>No other colors permitted</b> . No long sleeve undershirts are permitted.
Socks:	Choice of maroon tights or knee socks, grey tights or knee socks. If socks and tights are both worn, they must be of the same color
Hairstyle:	Hair must be kept neat and clean. No bizarre or exaggerated hairstyles are permitted. (Only natural color highlights/lowlights are permitted.)
	• If a headband is used it should coordinate with the uniform colors and be small in width.
Cosmetics:	Only simple use of cosmetics is permitted.
Jewelry:	Earrings: Only one pair of small earrings.
	Rings: Only a Mercy school ring is permitted.
	<ul> <li>Bracelets/Necklaces: Not permitted, including plastic bands of any kind.</li> </ul>
	Watches: Watches without alarms are permitted.
Tattoos:	Tattoos are not preferred. Inappropriate and or offensive tattoos as determined by Administration must be covered at all times by wearing the full school uniform.
Body piercing:	Body piercing jewelry including facial piercings are not permitted to be worn in school.

## Dress Code for Young Men

The young men may wear either black or grey dress pants, polo shirt with school emblem, school sweater with emblem, and low-top black, rubber-soled, laced shoes. Sneakers are not acceptable. Mercy Tech expects the young men to look professional so hair should be nicely groomed and not too long. Neatly trimmed facial hair is also allowed. <b>Dress Pants:</b>	Black or grey dress pants ordered from Flynn O'Hara Uniforms
	<ul> <li>Must be the proper length and worn at the waist</li> <li>No baggy or oversized pants will be permitted</li> </ul>
Shirt:	Short sleeve or long sleeve yellow, maroon, and/or ash grey polo shirt with the school emblem (uniform shirt must be tucked in)
Sweater:	Maroon and/or Heather Grey Pullover V-Neck/Cardigan Sweater with the school emblem
Shoes:	Low-top rubber soled shoes – Black only (Positively NO Boots of sneakers)
Undershirt:	If worn, white, gray, maroon, yellow – <b>No other colors permitted.</b> No long sleeve undershirts are permitted.
Shoes:	Low-top, rubber-soled, laced shoes – Black only (Positively NO boots or sneakers)
Belt:	Dress belts must be worn
Hair:	Hair must be kept neat and clean and may not extend below the top of the shirt collar. <b>Bizarre or exaggerated hairstyles are not permitted.</b> (Only natural color highlights/lowlights are permitted.)
Shaving:	Clean shaven is preferred. Neatly trimmed facial hair is permitted as a privilege that can be taken away by Administration.
Jewelry:	Earrings/Bracelets/Necklaces: Not permitted, including plastic bands of any kind.
	Rings: Only a Mercy school ring is permitted.
	Watches: Watches without alarms are permitted.
Tattoos:	Tattoos are not preferred. Inappropriate and or offensive tattoos as determined by Administration must be covered at all times by wearing the full school uniform.
<b>Body piercing:</b>	Body piercing jewelry including facial piercings are not permitted to be worn in school.
