Position Summary: This position is responsible for timely and accurate processing and receipting of pledges and gifts as well as day-to-day office management. This role will also assist in tasks related to stewardship execution.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Serve as the lead for all gift processing and documentation, including electronic filing system.
- Administer Raiser's Edge platform for data processes and improvements.
- Assist with stewardship initiatives and administration to include the Blackbaud Award Management System, management of consecutive giving loyalty mailings, the Annual Day of Giving mailings, and RSVP-management for stewardship events.
- Assist with the day-to-day office management, including all invoicing and supply orders.
- Assist with special projects as needed.
- Collaborate with a diverse community of constituents in all aspects of work.

- One year of experience in a related field required.
- Bachelor's degree preferred.
- Experience with Razor's Edge or similar platform preferred.
- Extensive knowledge and experience with MS Office and Google Workspace.
- Knowledge of general accounting principles and business practices.
