Proposition #1: 2020-2021 Budget

YES: 270 **NO: 96**
(226+44) (70+26)

Resolved, that the Board of Education of the Seneca Falls Central School District, Seneca County is hereby authorized to expend the sum of thirty-one million, five hundred thirty-six thousand, three hundred thirty-nine dollars (\$31,536,339.00) in the 2021-2022 school year with such amount to be raised by the levy of a tax upon the taxable property of such School District, after first deducting the monies available from State Aid and other sources as provided by law.

Proposition #2: Purchase Buses (4)

YES: 285 **NO: 81**
(234 +51) (62+19)

Resolved, that the Board of Education of the Seneca Falls Central School District, Seneca County is hereby authorized to purchase four (4) school buses for the transportation of District students, for a sum of money not to exceed five-hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000.00); said amount to be expended in the 2021-2022 fiscal year; said sum or so much thereof as may be necessary, shall be withdrawn from the District's "Capital Reserve Fund-Purchase of Buses", in accordance with the Education Law and Local Finance Law.

Proposition #3: Library Tax Increase

YES: 259 **NO: 107**
(216 + 43) (80 + 27)

Shall the sum of three hundred twenty-two thousand dollars (\$322,000.00) be raised by annual levy of a tax upon the taxable property within the Seneca Falls Central School District for the purpose of funding the Seneca Falls Library?
