Educational Research in District Schools

All requests to conduct research within the School District must be directed to the Superintendent. The following criteria will be utilized to make a determination regarding approval of such requests:

1. The study will result in direct benefits or provide direct services to the children within the School District;
2. The study will provide in-service opportunities for the growth and development of faculty and/or staff;
3. There will be no expenditures of District funds for any facet of the study.
4. There will be no use of staff/faculty time unless there are benefits as described in 1 and 2 above; and
5. Students participating in any study authorized by school administration are required to have written approval from their parent(s) or legal guardian(s) prior to the commencement of the study.

Final approval of educational research shall be at the discretion of the Board.
