Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) Financial Assistance Program

Belmont Hill's BYOD program requires students to bring a laptop to campus each day. Recognizing that this represents a significant expense to our families, the School has established a program of additional financial assistance to support this initiative.

Under the BYOD Financial Assistance Program, all Belmont Hill families receiving financial aid, regardless of the amount of the award, will receive either:

- A \$1,500 reduction in their tuition balance to cover the purchase and maintenance of a computer as required under the School's BYOD program;
- A new laptop provided by the School that meets all BYOD specifications in those cases where the family's tuition balance is less than \$1,500; or
- A loaner laptop provided by the School.

Awards will be granted while at Belmont Hill in accordance with the following schedule:
