School Summary:

Davis Connect High School, established in July 2020, is one of ten public schools in the Davis School District. Davis Connect enrolls a fully online K-12 student body. Our community is made up of families from cities across all of Davis County, Utah who are seeking an online school for their students. Some students opt for a blended schedule with their in-person boundary school. Davis Connect High School offers students an opportunity to excel academically and develop into responsible citizens.

Academics:

Full-time 9th–12th grade students are enrolled in a minimum of 7 classes for two semesters each school year. Students choose a learning format of either Online Classroom or Independent Study classes. Online Classroom has live video teaching twice per week, following the A/B Block Schedule of the district plus online learning activities in the Canvas platform. Independent Study is purely self-paced Canvas courses students work through on their own with teacher support and feedback.

Graduation candidates must earn a minimum of 24 credits in specific academic categories (27 for a graduation completion through their boundary school). Credits are earned at the rate of .25 credit per each quarter for each class.

Students must also have 35 Citizenship credits for graduation. Unweighted GPA's are calculated using a 4-point scale: A=4, B=3, C=2, D=1, F=0.
